- And **God** went on to say; Let luminaries come to be in the expanse of the heavens to make a division between the day and the night, and they must serve as signs and for seasons and for days and years. (**Genesis 1:14**)
- After that Pharaoh said to Joseph; Since **God** has caused you to know all this, there is no one as discreet and wise as you are. (**Genesis 41:39**)
- But now do not feel hurt and do not be angry with yourselves because **you** sold me here, because for the preservation of life **God** has sent me ahead of **you**. (**Genesis 45:5**)
- For this is the second year of the famine in the midst of the earth, and there are yet five years in which there will be no plowing time or harvest. (**Genesis 45:6**)
- Consequently **God** sent me ahead of **you** in order to place a remnant for **you** men in the earth and to keep **you** alive by a great escape. (**Genesis 45:7**)
- Can you send forth **lightnings** that they may go and say to you, Here we are! (**Job 38:35**)
- And as for the likeness of the living creatures, their appearance was like **burning** coals of **fire**. Something like the appearance of torches was moving back and forth between the living creatures, and the **fire** was bright, and out of the **fire** there was lightning going forth. (**Ezekiel 1:13**)
- And on the third day when it became morning it came about that **thunders** and **lightnings** began occurring, and a heavy cloud upon the mountain and a very loud sound of a horn, so that all the people who were in the camp began to tremble. (**Exodus 19:16**)
- Now all the people were seeing the **thunders** and the lightning flashes and the sound of the horn and the mountain smoking.

- When the people got to see it, then they quivered and stood at a distance. (**Exodus 20:18**)
- And you must make a lampstand of pure gold. Of hammered work the lampstand is to be made. Its base, its branches, its cups, its knobs and its blossoms are to proceed out from it. (**Exodus 25:31**)
  - Then he placed the lampstand in the tent of meeting in front of the table, on the side of the tabernacle to the south. (**Exodus 40:24**)
  - Then he said to me; What are you seeing? So I said; I have seen, and, look! There is a lampstand, all of it of gold, with a bowl on top of it. And its **seven lamps** are upon it, even **seven**, and the **lamps** that are at the top of it have **seven** pipes. (**Zechariah 4:2**)
  - John to the **seven** congregations that are in the district of Asia; May **you** have undeserved kindness and peace from, The One who is and who was and who is coming, and from the **seven spirits** that are **before** his **throne**. (**Revelation 1:4**)
  - And to the angel of the congregation in Sardis write; These are the things that he says who has the **seven spirits** of **God** and the **seven** stars, I know your deeds, that you have the name that you are alive, but you are dead. (**Revelation 3:1**)
  - But right away the angel took the incense vessel, and he filled it with some of the **fire** of the altar and hurled it to the earth. And **thunders** occurred and **voices** and **lightnings** and an earthquake. (**Revelation 8:5**)
  - And he cried out with a loud voice just as when a lion roars. And when he cried out, the **seven thunders** uttered their own **voices**. (**Revelation 10:3**)
