Revelation 6:10... And they cried with a loud voice, saying; Until when, Sovereign Lord holy and true, are you refraining from judging and avenging our blood upon those who dwell on the earth?

- It is unthinkable of you that you are acting in this manner to put to death the righteous man with the wicked one so that it has to occur with the righteous man as it does with the wicked! It is unthinkable of you. Is the Judge of all the earth not going to do what is right? (Genesis 18:25)
- And I heard a voice out of heaven say; Write; Happy are the dead who die in union with the Lord from this time onward. Yes, says the spirit, let them rest from their labors, for the things they did go right with them. (Revelation 14:13)
- Upon hearing this they with one accord raised their voices to God and said; Sovereign Lord, you are the One who made the heaven and the earth and the sea and all the things in them. (Acts of Apostles 4:24)
- But we know that the Son of God has come, and he has given us intellectual capacity that we may gain the knowledge of the true one. And we are in union with the true one, by means of his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and life everlasting. (1 John 5:20)
- Certainly, then, shall not God cause justice to be done for his chosen ones who cry out to him day and night, even though he is long-suffering toward them? (Luke 18:7)
- In general assembly, and the congregation of the firstborn who have been enrolled in the heavens, and God the Judge of all, and the spiritual lives of righteous ones who have been made perfect. (Hebrews 12:23)
- Because his judgments are true and righteous. For he has executed judgment upon the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication, and he has avenged the blood of his slaves at her hand. (Revelation 19:2)

- At this he said; What have you done? Listen! Your brother's blood is crying out to me from the ground. (Genesis 4:10)
- Be glad, you nations, with his people, for he will avenge the blood of his servants, and he will pay back vengeance to his adversaries and will indeed make atonement for the ground of his people. (Deuteronomy 32:43)
- Then Reuben answered them, saying; Did not I say to You; Do not sin against the child, but You did not listen? And now his blood, here it is certainly asked back. (Genesis 42:22)
- But you are Yehowah the Sovereign Lord. Deal with me for the sake of your name. Because your loving-kindness is good, deliver me. (Psalms 109:21)
- How many are the days of your servant? When will you execute judgment against those persecuting me? (Psalms 119:84)
- Say to those who are anxious at heart; Be strong. Do not be afraid. Look! Your own God will come with vengeance itself, God even with a repayment. He himself will come and save you people. (Isaiah 35:4)
- Look! I am against you, O Presumptuousness, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, for your day must come, the time that I must give you attention (Jeremiah 50:31)
- The violence done to me and to my organism be upon Babylon! The inhabitress of Zion will say. And my blood be upon the inhabitants of Chaldea! Jerusalem will say. (Jeremiah 51:35)
- And you must bring them near before Yehowah, and the priests must throw salt upon them and offer them up as a whole burnt offering to Yehowah. (Ezekiel 43:24)
- And I got to hear a certain holy one speaking, and another holy one proceeded to say to the particular one who was speaking; How long will the vision be of the constant feature and of the transgression causing desolation, to make both the holy place and the army things to trample on? (Daniel 8:13)
- Then one said to the man clothed with the linen, who was up above the waters of the stream; How long will it be to the end of the wonderful things? (Daniel 12:6)

- How long, O Yehowah, must I cry for help, and you do not hear? How long shall I call to you for aid from violence, and you do not save? (Habakkuk 1:2)
- Because you yourself despoiled many nations, all the remaining ones of the peoples will despoil you, because of the shedding of blood of mankind and the violence to the earth, the town and all those dwelling in it. (Habakkuk 2:8)
- This takes into account that it is righteous on God's part to repay tribulation to those who make tribulation for YOU. (2 Thessalonians 1:6)
- Be glad over her, O heaven, also you holy ones and you apostles and you prophets, because God has judicially exacted punishment for you from her! (Revelation 18:20)
- Yes, in her was found the blood of prophets and of holy ones and of all those who have been slaughtered on the earth. (Revelation 18:24)
