

**Revelation 6:16** And they keep saying to the mountains and to the rock-masses; Fall over us and hide us from the face of the One seated on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb.

[10] - References:

- And the high places of Beth-aven, the sin of Israel, will actually be annihilated. Thorns and thistles themselves will come up upon their altars. And people will in fact say to the **mountains**; Cover us! And to the hills; Fall over us! (**Hosea 10:8**)
- Then they will start to say to the **mountains**; Fall over us! And to the hills; Cover us over! (**Luke 23:30**)
- After these things I immediately came to be in the power of the spirit; and, look! A **throne** was in its position in heaven, and there is one **seated** upon the **throne**. (**Revelation 4:2**)
- And I saw standing in the midst of the **throne** and of the four living creatures and in the midst of the elders a lamb as though it had been slaughtered, having seven horns and seven eyes, which eyes mean the seven spirits of God that have been sent forth into the whole earth. (**Revelation 5:6**)
- Kiss the son, that He may not become incensed and **you** may not perish from the way, for his anger flares up easily. Happy are all those taking refuge in him. (**Psalms 2:12**)
- For it is the day of confusion and of downtreading and of confounding that the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, has in the valley of the vision. There is the demolisher of the wall, and the cry to the mountain. (**Isaiah 22:5**)
- And I will bring my vengeance on Edom by the hand of my people Israel, and they must do in Edom according to my anger and according to my rage, and they will have to know what my vengeance is, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 25:14**)
- The great day of Yehowah is near. It is near, and there is a hurrying of it very much. The sound of the day of Yehowah is bitter. There a mighty man is letting out a cry. (**Zephaniah 1:14**)

- **And the second angel blew his trumpet. And something like a great mountain burning with fire was hurled into the sea. And a third of the sea became blood. (Revelation 8:8)**
