[21] - References:

- The **wind blows** where it wants to, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know where it comes from and where it is going. So is everyone that has been born from the spirit. (**John 3:8**)
- And he will send forth his **angels** with a great trumpet sound, and they will gather his chosen ones together from the **four winds**, from one extremity of the heavens to their other extremity. (**Matthew 24:31**)
- In order that we should no longer be babes, tossed about as by waves and carried hither and thither by every **wind** of teaching by means of the trickery of men, by means of cunning in contriving error. (**Ephesians 4:14**)
- And the rain poured down and the floods came and the **winds** blew and lashed against that house, but it did not cave in, for it had been founded upon the rock-mass. (**Matthew 7:25**)
- For it is **wind** that they keep sowing, and a storm **wind** is what they will reap. Nothing has **standing** grain. No sprout produces flour. Should any perhaps produce it, strangers themselves will swallow it down. (**Hosea 8:7**)
- At his voice there is a giving by him of a turmoil of waters in the heavens, and he causes vapors to ascend from the extremity of the **earth**. He has made even sluices for the rain, and he brings forth the **wind** from his storehouses. (**Jeremiah 10:13**)
- At that time the iron, the molded clay, the copper, the silver and the gold were, all together, crushed and became like the chaff from the summer threshing floor, and the **wind** carried them away so that no trace at all was found of them. And as for the stone that struck the image, it became a large mountain and filled the whole **earth**. (**Daniel 2:35**)

- **A wind will shepherd all your own shepherds, and as for those intensely loving you, they will go into captivity itself. For at that time you will be ashamed and certainly feel humiliated because of all your calamity. (Jeremiah 22:22)**
- **O my God, make them like a thistle whirl, like stubble before a wind. (Psalms 83:13)**
- **You fire and hail, snow and thick smoke, you tempestuous wind, accomplishing his word. (Psalms 148:8)**
- **And Yehowah says; For the reason that this people have come near with their mouth, and they have glorified me merely with their lips, and they have removed their heart itself far away from me, and their fear toward me becomes men's commandment that is being taught. (Isaiah 29:13)**
- **From Yehowah of armies you will have attention with thunder and with quaking and with a great sound, storm wind and tempest, and the flame of a devouring fire. (Isaiah 29:6)**
- **May they become like chaff before the wind, and let Yehowah's angel be pushing them along. (Psalms 35:5)**
- **Look! I have made you a threshing sledge, a new threshing instrument having double-edged teeth. You will tread down the mountains and crush them, and the hills you will make just like the chaff. (Isaiah 41:15)**
- **You will winnow them, and a wind itself will carry them away, and a windstorm itself will drive them different ways. And you yourself will be joyful in Yehowah. In the Holy One of Israel you will boast about yourself. (Isaiah 41:16)**
- **When the Son of man arrives in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit down on his glorious throne. (Matthew 25:31)**
- **This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Look! A calamity is going forth from nation to nation, and a great tempest itself will be roused up from the remotest parts of the earth. (Jeremiah 25:32)**
- **I have seen the wicked a tyrant and spreading himself as a luxuriant tree in native soil. (Psalms 37:35)**

- **His hand he has stretched out over the sea, he has caused kingdoms to be agitated. Yehowah himself has given a command against Phoenicia, to annihilate her strongholds. (Isaiah 23:11)**
- **And I will bring in upon Elam the four winds from the four extremities of the heavens. And I will scatter them to all these winds, and there will prove to be no nation to which the dispersed ones of Elam will not come. (Jeremiah 49:36)**
