- Only with your eyes will you look on and see the retribution itself of the wicked ones. (**Psalms 91:8**)
- Because you said; Yehowah is my refuge, you have made the Most High himself your dwelling. (**Psalms 91:9**)
- No calamity will befall you, and not even a plague will draw near to your tent. (**Psalms 91:10**)
- For he will give his own angels a command concerning you, to guard you in all your ways. (**Psalms 91:11**)
- And they took no note until the flood came and swept them all away, so the presence of the Son of man will be. (**Matthew 24:39**)
- Then two men will be in the field, one will be taken along and the other be abandoned. (**Matthew 24:40**)
- Two women will be grinding at the hand mill, one will be taken along and the other be abandoned. (**Matthew 24:41**)
- Keep on the watch, therefore, because **YOU** do not know on what day **YOUR** Lord is coming. (**Matthew 24:42**)
- When the Son of man arrives in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit down on his glorious **throne**. (**Matthew 25:31**)
- But **YOU** have approached a Mount Zion and a city of the **living God**, heavenly Jerusalem, and myriads of angels. (**Hebrews 12:22**)
- And the twenty-four **elders** who were seated **before God** upon their **thrones** fell upon their **faces** and **worshiped God**. (**Revelation 11:16**)

- **And they are singing as if a new song **before** the **throne** and **before** the **four living creatures** and the **elders**, and no one was able to master that song but the hundred and forty-four thousand, who have been bought from the earth. (**Revelation 14:3**)**
- **O come in, let us worship and bow down, let us kneel **before** Yehowah our Maker. (**Psalms 95:6**)**
- **And David went on to say to all the congregation; Bless, now, Yehowah **YOUR** God. And all the congregation proceeded to bless Yehowah the **God** of their forefathers and bow low and prostrate themselves to Yehowah and to the king. (**1 Chronicles 29:20**)**
- **Then Ezra blessed Yehowah the true **God**, the great One, at which all the people answered, Amen! Amen! With the lifting up of their hands. They then bowed low and prostrated themselves to Yehowah with their **faces** to the earth. (**Nehemiah 8:6**)**
- **And the **four living creatures** went saying; Amen! And the **elders** **fell** down and **worshiped**. (**Revelation 5:14**)**
- **And I heard a voice as if in the midst of the **four living creatures** say; A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius, and do not harm the olive oil and the wine. (**Revelation 6:6**)**
