

**Revelation 7:15** • **That is why they are before the throne of God, and they are rendering him sacred service<sup>1</sup> day and night in his temple;<sup>2</sup> and the One seated on the throne will spread his tent over them.**

- **But on being asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God was coming, he answered them and said; The kingdom of God is not coming with striking observableness. (Luke 17:20)**
- **Yehowah is in his holy temple. Yehowah, in the heavens is his throne. His own eyes behold, his own beaming eyes examine the sons of men. (Psalms 11:4)**
- **Then Jesus said to him; Go away, Satan! For it is written: It is Yehowah your God you must worship, and it is to him alone you must render sacred service. (Matthew 4:10)**
- **And she was a widow now eighty-four years old, who was never missing from the temple, rendering sacred service night and day with fastings and supplications. (Luke 2:37)**
- **After these things I immediately came to be in the power of the spirit; and, look! A throne was in its position in heaven, and there is one seated upon the throne. (Revelation 4:2)**
- **O Yehowah, who will be a guest in your tent? Who will reside in your holy mountain? (Psalms 15:1)**
- **With that I heard a loud voice from the throne say; Look! The tent of God is with mankind, and he will reside with them, and they will be his peoples. And God himself will be with them. (Revelation 21:3)**
- **O bless Yehowah, all YOU servants of Yehowah, YOU who are standing in the house of Yehowah during the nights. (Psalms 134:1)**

- Surely the righteous themselves **will** give thanks to your name, the upright ones **will** dwell **before** your face. (**Psalms 140:13**)
- And it must occur in that **day** that there **will** be the root of Jesse that **will** be standing up as a signal for the peoples. To him even the nations **will** turn inquiringly, and his resting-place must become glorious. (**Isaiah 11:10**)
- And strangers **will** actually stand and shepherd the flocks of **YOU** people, and the foreigners **will** be **YOUR** farmers and **YOUR** vinedressers. (**Isaiah 61:5**)
- But when they are made to stumble they **will** be helped with a little help, and many **will** certainly join themselves to them by means of smoothness. (**Daniel 11:34**)
