Revelation 7:15. That is why they are before the throne of God, and they are rendering him sacred service day and night in his temple; and the One seated on the throne will spread his tent over them.

- But on being asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God was coming, he answered them and said; The kingdom of God is not coming with striking observableness. (Luke 17:20)

- O Yehowah, who will be a guest in your tent? Who will reside in your holy mountain? (Psalms 15:1)
- With that I heard a loud voice from the throne say; Look! The tent of God is with mankind, and he will reside with them, and they will be his peoples. And God himself will be with them. (Revelation 21:3)
- O bless Yehowah, all you servants of Yehowah, you who are standing in the house of Yehowah during the nights. (Psalms 134:1)

- Surely the righteous themselves will give thanks to your name, the upright ones will dwell before your face. (Psalms 140:13)
- And it must occur in that day that there will be the root of Jesse that will be standing up as a signal for the peoples. To him even the nations will turn inquiringly, and his resting-place must become glorious. (Isaiah 11:10)
- And strangers will actually stand and shepherd the flocks of You people, and the foreigners will be Your farmers and Your vinedressers. (Isaiah 61:5)
- But when they are made to stumble they will be helped with a little help, and many will certainly join themselves to them by means of smoothness. (Daniel 11:34)
