- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Do not listen to the words of the prophets who are prophesying to **YOU** people. They are making **YOU** become vain. The vision of their own heart is what they speak, not from the mouth of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 23:16**)
- They are saying again and again to those who are disrespectful of me; Yehowah has spoken; Peace is what **YOU** people will come to have. And to every one walking in the stubbornness of his heart they have said, No calamity will come upon **YOU** people. (**Jeremiah 23:17**)
- For who has stood in the intimate group of Yehowah that he might see and hear his word? Who has given attention to his word that he might hear it? (**Jeremiah 23:18**)
- Look! The windstorm of Yehowah, rage itself, will certainly go forth, even a whirling tempest. Upon the head of the wicked ones it will whirl itself. (**Jeremiah 23:19**)
- The anger of Yehowah will not turn back until he will have carried out and until he will have **made** the ideas of his heart come true. In the final part of the days **YOU** people will give **YOUR** consideration to it with understanding. (**Jeremiah 23:20**)
- That there may not be among **YOU** a man or a woman or a family or a tribe whose heart is turning today away from Yehowah our God to go and serve the gods of those nations, that there may not be among **YOU** a root bearing the fruit of a poisonous plant and **wormwood**. (**Deuteronomy 29:18**)
- For the word of God is alive and exerts power and is sharper than any two-edged sword and pierces even to the dividing of soul and spirit, and of joints and their marrow, and is able to discern thoughts and intentions of the heart. (**Hebrews 4:12**)

- And he had in his right hand seven **stars**, and out of his mouth a sharp, long two-edged sword was protruding, and his countenance was as the sun when it shines in its power. **(Revelation 1:16)**
- And out of his mouth there protrudes a sharp long sword, that he may strike the nations with it, and he will shepherd them with a rod of iron. He treads too the winepress of the anger of the wrath of God the Almighty. **(Revelation 19:15)**
- And in reply the king will say to them; Truly I say to **YOU**, to the extent that **YOU** did it to one of the least of these my brothers, **YOU** did it to me. **(Matthew 25:40)**
- Then he will answer them with the words; Truly I say to **YOU**, to the extent that **YOU** did not do it to one of these least ones, **YOU** did not do it to me. **(Matthew 25:45)**
- But the aftereffect from her is as **bitter** as **wormwood**, it is as sharp as a two-edged sword. **(Proverbs 5:4)**
- Therefore this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Here I am making them, that is, this people, eat **wormwood**, and I will make them drink poisoned water. **(Jeremiah 9:15)**
- A fouled spring and a ruined well is the righteous one when staggering before the wicked one. **(Proverbs 25:26)**
- O **YOU** who are turning justice into mere **wormwood**, and the ones who have cast righteousness itself to the earth. **(Amos 5:7)**
- On a crag will horses run, or will one plow there with cattle? For into a poisonous plant **YOU** people have **turned** justice, and the fruitage of righteousness into **wormwood**. **(Amos 6:12)**
- The time must come, the day must arrive. As regards the buyer, let him not rejoice, and as regards the seller, let him not go into mourning, for there is hot feeling against all its crowd. **(Ezekiel 7:12)**
