

Revelation 8:5 But right away the angel took the incense vessel, and he filled it with some of the fire of the altar and hurled it to the earth. And thunders occurred and voices and lightning's and an earthquake.

- And when he got nearby, he viewed the city and wept over it. (Luke 19:41)
- Saying; If you, even you, had discerned in this day the things having to do with peace, but now they have been hid from your eyes. (Luke 19:42)
- Because the days will come upon you when your enemies will build around you a fortification with pointed stakes and will encircle you and distress you from every side. (Luke 19:43)
- And they will dash you and your children within you to the ground, and they will not leave a stone upon a stone in you, because you did not discern the time of your being inspected. (Luke 19:44)
- There is a lion that has roared! Who will not be afraid? The Sovereign Lord Yehowah himself has spoken! Who will not prophesy? (Amos 3:8)
- But Jesus, calling them to him, said; You know that the rulers of the nations lord it over them and the great men wield authority over them. (Matthew 20:25)
- This is not the way among YOU, but whoever wants to become great among YOU must be YOUR minister. (Matthew 20:26)
- And whoever wants to be first among YOU must be YOUR slave. (Matthew 20:27)
- Just as the Son of man came, not to be ministered to, but to minister and to give his soul a ransom in exchange for many. (Matthew 20:28)
- And they were told to harm no vegetation of the earth nor any green thing nor any tree, but only those men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads. (Revelation 9:4)

- **And it was granted the locusts, not to kill them, but that these should be tormented five months, and the torment upon them was as torment by a scorpion when it strikes a man. (Revelation 9:5)**
- **All the works they do they do to be viewed by men, for they broaden the scripture-containing cases that they wear as safeguards, and enlarge the fringes of their garments. (Matthew 23:5)**
- **They like the most prominent place at evening meals and the front seats in the synagogues. (Matthew 23:6)**
- **And the greetings in the marketplaces and to be called Rabbi by men. (Matthew 23:7)**
- **But YOU, do not YOU be called Rabbi, for one is YOUR teacher, whereas all YOU are brothers. (Matthew 23:8)**
- **Moreover, do not call anyone YOUR father on earth, for one is YOUR Father, the heavenly One. (Matthew 23:9)**
- **Neither be called leaders, for YOUR Leader is one, the Christ. (Matthew 23:10)**
- **But the greatest one among YOU must be YOUR minister. (Matthew 23:11)**
- **And when he got nearby, he viewed the city and wept over it. (Luke 19:41)**

- **Nevertheless, you do have a few names in Sardis that did not defile their outer garments, and they shall walk with me in white ones, because they are worthy. (Revelation 3:4)**
- **He that conquers will thus be arrayed in white outer garments, and I will by no means blot out his name from the book of life, but I will make acknowledgment of his name before my Father and before his angels. (Revelation 3:5)**
- **I advise you to buy from me gold refined by fire that you may become rich, and white outer garments that you may become dressed and that the shame of your nakedness may not become manifested, and eyesalve to rub in your eyes that you may see. (Revelation 3:18)**
- **And I myself shall collect together the remnant of my sheep out of all the lands to which I had dispersed them, and I will bring them back to their pasture ground, and they will certainly be fruitful and become many. (Jeremiah 23:3)**
- **Moreover, Isaiah cries out concerning Israel; Although the number of the sons of Israel may be as the sand of the sea, it is the remnant that will be saved. (Romans 9:27)**
- **In this way, therefore, at the present season also a remnant has turned up according to a choosing due to undeserved kindness. (Romans 11:5)**
- **And they began to say one to the other; Unquestionably we are guilty with regard to our brother, because we saw the distress of his soul when he implored compassion on our part, but we did not listen. That is why this distress has come upon us. (Genesis 42:21)**
- **At that, one of the seraphs flew to me, and in his hand there was a glowing coal that he had taken with tongs off the altar. (Isaiah 6:6)**
- **I came to start a fire on the earth, and what more is there for me to wish if it has already been lighted? (Luke 12:49)**
- **And on the third day when it became morning it came about that thunders and lightnings began occurring, and a heavy cloud upon the mountain and a very loud sound of a horn, so that all the people who were in the camp began to tremble. (Exodus 19:16)**

- And out of the throne there are proceeding lightnings and **voices** and **thunders**, and there are seven lamps of **fire** burning before the throne, and these mean the seven spirits of God. (**Revelation 4:5**)
- Now when the seven **thunders** spoke, I was at the point of writing, but I heard a voice out of heaven say; Seal up the things the seven **thunders** spoke, and do not write them down. (**Revelation 10:4**)
- And lightnings and **voices** and **thunders occurred**, and a great **earthquake occurred** such as had not **occurred** since men came to be on the **earth**, so extensive an **earthquake**, so great. (**Revelation 16:18**)
- His lightnings lighted up the productive land, the **earth** saw and came to be in severe pains. (**Psalms 97:4**)
- And I saw when he opened the sixth seal, and a great **earthquake occurred**, and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the entire moon became as blood. (**Revelation 6:12**)
- And it **occurred** that it was seen that Moab was made weary upon the high place, and he came to his sanctuary to pray, and he could not accomplish anything. (**Isaiah 16:12**)
- The islands saw and began to fear. The very extremities of the **earth** began trembling. They drew near and kept coming. (**Isaiah 41:5**)
- And he proceeded to say to the man clothed with the linen, even to say; Enter in between the wheelwork, in under the cherubs, and fill the hollows of both your hands with coals of **fire** from between the cherubs and toss them over the city. So he entered in before my eyes. (**Ezekiel 10:2**)
- And the very sound of the wings of the cherubs made itself heard to the outer courtyard, like the sound of God Almighty when he speaks. (**Ezekiel 10:5**)
- So it came about after all your badness, woe, woe to you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah (**Ezekiel 16:23**)
- And the men were scorched with great heat, but they blasphemed the name of God, who has the authority over these

**plagues, and they did not repent so as to give glory to him.
