- That there may come upon **you** all the righteous blood spilled on earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah son of Barachiah, whom **you** murdered between the sanctuary and the **altar**. (**Matthew 23:35**)
- And the seven **angels** with the seven **trumpets** prepared to blow them. (**Revelation 8:6**)
- And the seventh **angel blew** his **trumpet**. And loud **voices** occurred in heaven, saying; The kingdom of the world did become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he will rule as king forever and ever. (**Revelation 11:15**)
- And I turned to see the **voice** that was speaking with me, and, having turned, I saw seven **golden** lampstands. (**Revelation 1:12**)
- And another **angel** arrived and stood at the **altar**, having a **golden** incense vessel, and a large quantity of incense was given him to offer it with the prayers of all the holy ones upon the **golden altar** that was **before** the throne. (**Revelation 8:3**)
- And the **altar** hearth is four cubits, and **out** from the **altar** hearth and upward there are the four **horns**. (**Ezekiel 43:15**)
- And the sixth one poured **out** his bowl upon the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, that the way might be prepared for the kings from the rising of the sun. (**Revelation 16:12**)
