~ABHORRENCE (43)

[English, hatred, loathing, disgust, detestation, repugnance, revulsion, abomination, Opposite of, adoration]

- Hadad the King of Syria possessed an abhorrence of Israel all his days as a continuing resister toward Israel.
- And God proceeded to raise up to him another resister, namely, Rezon the son of Eliada, who had run away from Hadadezer the king of Zobah his lord. (1 Kings 11:23)
- And he kept collecting men to his side and came to be chief of a marauder band, when David killed them. So they went to Damascus and took up dwelling in it and began reigning in Damascus. (1 Kings 11:24)
- And he came to be a resister of Israel all the days of Solomon, and that along with the injury that Hadad did, and he had an abhorrence of Israel while he continued reigning over Syria. (1 Kings 11:25)
- Daniel prophesies that many will awake from the sleep of death to indefinitely lasting abhorrence by God for their judgment will be one of eternal death.
- And there will be many of those asleep in the ground of dust who will wake up, these to indefinitely lasting life and those to reproaches and to indefinitely lasting abhorrence. (Daniel 12:2)
- The Apostle Paul counseled Christians to actually practice what they preach. Otherwise their worship would be hypocritical.
- For example if someone today realizes the falseness of Christmas and the lighting of Christmas trees, a practice coming from the Roman Saturnaillia, which is idol worship, and then they go out and look at the Christmas lights each year, they would, in truth, not be abhorring the idol as they should.
- You, the one saying; Do not commit adultery. Do you commit adultery? You, the one expressing abhorrence of the idols, do you rob temples? (Romans 2:22)
