

**~ABI-ALBON (42)**  
**(A'bi-al'bon)**

- **A Benjamite and an outstanding warrior listed among 37 of King David's most valiant fighters.**
- **Abi-albon** the Arbathite, Azmaveth the Bar-humite. (**2 Samuel 23:31**)
- **He is evidently the Abiel** referred to in a parallel passage at;
- **Hurai from the torrent valleys of Gaash, Abiel** the Arbathite. (**1 Chronicles 11:32**)
- **He is called the Arbathite**, perhaps because of coming from the city of Beth-arabah, which lay near the frontier between Benjamin and Judah above the North end of the Dead Sea.
- **And the boundary went up to Beth-hoglah and passed over at the north of Beth-arabah, and the boundary went up to the stone of Bohan the son of Reuben. (Joshua 15:6)**
- **And it passed over to the northern slope in front of the Arabah and went down to the Arabah. (Joshua 18:18)**
- **And the cities of the tribe of the sons of Benjamin by their families proved to be Jericho and Beth-hoglah and Emek-keziz. (Joshua 18:21)**
- **His fighting valor was in accord with Jacob's deathbed prophecy concerning the tribe of Benjamin.**
- **Benjamin will keep on tearing like a wolf. In the morning he will eat the animal seized and at evening he will divide spoil. (Genesis 49:27)**
