~ABI-EZER 3 (45) (Abi-e'zer) [My Father Is a Helper]

- A Benjamite from Anathoth, one of King David's 37 most valiant fighters.
- Abi-ezer the Anathothite, Mebunnai the Hushathite. (2 Samuel 23:27)
- Uriah the Hittite, thirty-seven in all. (2 Samuel 23:39)
- He was head of a paternal house and divisional head over a force of 24,000 fellow tribesmen, serving the king during the ninth month of each year.
- Ira the son of Ikkesh the Tekoite, Abi-ezer the Anathothite. (1 Chronicles 11:28)
- As for the sons of Israel by their number, the heads of the paternal houses and the chiefs of the thousands and of the hundreds and their officers that were ministering to the king in every matter of the divisions of those that came in and that went out month by month for all the months of the year, each division was twenty-four thousand. (1 Chronicles 27:1)
- The ninth for the ninth month was Abi-ezer the Anathothite of the Benjaminites, and in his division there were twenty-four thousand. (1 Chronicles 27:12)
- · Along with other Benjamites, by his valor in war he fulfilled the prophecy at,
- Benjamin will keep on tearing like a wolf. In the morning he will eat the animal seized and at evening he will divide spoil. (Genesis 49:27)
- His town of Anathoth lay a few miles North-Northeast of Jerusalem, within the territory of Benjamin.
- And from the tribe of Benjamin Geba with its pasture grounds and Alemeth with its pasture grounds and Anathoth with its pasture grounds. All their cities were thirteen cities among their

families. (1 Chronicles 6:60)
