~ABI-EZRITE (30) (Abi-ez'rite) [Of, or Belonging to Abi-ezer]

- A descendant of Abi-ezer, of the family of Abi-ezer.
- Later Yehowah's angel came and sat under the big tree that was in Ophrah, which belonged to Joash the Abi-ezrite, while Gideon his son was beating out wheat in the winepress so as to get it quickly out of the sight of Midian. (Judges 6:11)
- So Gideon built an altar there to Yehowah, and it continues to be called Yehowah-shalom down to this day. It is yet in Ophrah of the Abi-ezrites. (Judges 6:24)
- Eventually Gideon the son of Joash died at a good old age and was buried in the burial place of Joash his father in Ophrah of the Abi-ezrites. (Judges 8:32)
- These were the sons of Gilead. Of Iezer the family of the Iezerites. Of Helek the family of the Helekites. (Numbers 26:30)
- Reads Iezerites, Jeezerites, KJ, which is a contraction of Abiezrites. This term is applied in the Bible to those descended from Abi-ezer the son of Gilead, rather than to the Abi-ezer of David's time.
