~ABIDAN (73) (Ab'i-dan) [My Father Has Judged]

- The chieftain of the tribe of Benjamin at the time of the census of Israel in the second year following the Exodus from Egypt.
- Of Benjamin, Abidan the son of Gideoni. (Numbers 1:11)
- These are the one's called of the assembly, the chieftains of the tribes of their fathers. They are the heads of the thousands of Israel. (Numbers 1:16)
- He was the head over the 35,400 men of Benjamin over 20 years of age who camped on the West side of the tabernacle.
- The three-tribe division of the camp of Ephraim in their armies will be toward the west, and the chieftain for the sons of Ephraim is Elishama the son of Ammihud. (Numbers 2:18)
- And the tribe of Benjamin, and the chieftain for the sons of Benjamin is **Abidan** the son of Gideoni. (Numbers 2:22)
- And his army and the one's registered of them are thirty-five thousand four hundred. (Numbers 2:23)
- At the completion of the tabernacle and its inauguration 1512 B.C.E, during 12 days each chieftain presented a noncompetitive offering of silver and gold dishware, worth about \$1,720, in addition to offerings of grain, oil, incense, and livestock, and it was on the ninth day that Abidan did so.
- Now the chieftains made their presentation at the inauguration of the altar on the day of its being anointed, and the chieftains proceeded with presenting their offering before the altar. (Numbers 7:10)
- On the ninth day there was the chieftain for the sons of Benjamin, Abidan the son of Gideoni. (Numbers 7:60)
- His offering was one silver dish, its weight being a hundred and thirty shekels, one silver bowl of seventy shekels by the shekel of

the holy place, both of them full of fine flour moistened with oil for a grain offering. (Numbers 7:61)

- One gold cup of ten shekels, full of incense. (Numbers 7:62)
- One young bull, one ram, one male lamb in its first year, for a burnt offering. (Numbers 7:63)
- One kid of the goats for a sin offering. (Numbers 7:64)
- And for a communion sacrifice two cattle, five rams, five hegoats, five male lambs each a year old. This was the offering of Abidan the son of Gideoni. (Numbers 7:65)
- He died during the 40-year journey in the wilderness.
- In this wilderness your carcasses will fall, yes, all your registered one's of all your number from twenty years old upward, you who have murmured against me.

- As for you, you will not enter into the land in which I lifted up my hand in oath to reside with you, except Caleb the son of Jephunneh and Joshua the son of Nun. (Numbers 14:30)
