

~ABODE (73)

[English, house, residence, dwelling, habitat, domicile]

- Balaam prophesied that the **dwelling** place of the Kenites was durable, their **abode** was set upon a crag.
- When he got to see the Kenites, he carried further his proverbial utterance and went on to say; Durable is your dwelling, and set on the crag is your **abode**. (**Numbers 24:21**)
- Wise King Solomon stated that he had successfully built a lofty, **by human standards**, **abode** for Yehowah to dwell in to time indefinite.
- I have successfully built a house of lofty **abode** for you, an established place for you to dwell in to time indefinite. (**1 Kings 8:13**)
- And I, for my part, have built a house of lofty **abode** for you and an established place for you to dwell in to time indefinite. (**2 Chronicles 6:2**)
- The Psalmist shows that the stupid one's lift themselves up above others, but rather than a lofty **abode**, Sheol, the grave, will be their dwelling place.
- Like sheep they have been appointed to Sheol itself, death itself will shepherd them, and the upright one's will have them in subjection in the morning, and their forms are due to wear away, Sheol rather than a lofty **abode** is for each one. (**Psalms 49:14**)
- Here the Proverb shows that the wise one's will store up treasure and oil to deal with future needs, but the stupid one's simply consume everything. Therefore the **abode** of the wise one's is where he has stored up extra for a time of need.
- Desirable treasure and oil are in the **abode** of the wise one, but the man that is stupid will swallow it up. (**Proverbs 21:20**)
- And let them collect all the foodstuffs of these coming good years, and let them pile up grain under Pharaoh's hand as foodstuffs in the cities, and they must safeguard it. (**Genesis 41:35**)

- After that Pharaoh said to Joseph; Since God has caused you to know all this, there is no one as discreet and wise as you are. (**Genesis 41:39**)
- Here Yehowah's qualities of holiness and beauty are likened to his **abode** or **dwelling** place.
- Look from heaven and see out of your lofty **abode** of holiness and beauty. Where are your zeal and your full might, the commotion of your inward parts, and your mercies? Toward me they have restrained themselves. (**Isaiah 63:15**)
- Here the heavens are likened to a lofty **abode**.
- Sun, moon, stood still, in the lofty **abode** thereof. Like light your own arrows kept going. The lightning of your spear served for brightness. (**Habakkuk 3:11**)
- Jesus statement shows that all who love Yehowah and his Christ would have them dwell or make their **abode** with them in spirit.
- In answer Jesus said to him; If anyone loves me, he will observe my word, and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him and make our **abode** with him. (**John 14:23**)
