~ABUNDANCE (485)

[English, profusion, large quantity, plenty, loads, wealth, opposite of, scarcity]

- Here the blessing of Jacob is for an abundance of grain and new wine referring to spiritual food and rejoicing.
- And may the true God give you the dews of the heavens and the fertile soils of the earth and an abundance of grain and new wine. (Genesis 27:28)
- Yehowah is not just better than men, but he is abundantly superior.
- And in the abundance of your superiority you can throw down those who rise up against you. You send out your burning anger, it eats them up like stubble. (Exodus 15:7)
- Would he with an abundance of power contend with me? O no! Surely he himself would pay heed to me. (Job 23:6)
- As for the Almighty, we have not found him out, he is exalted in power, and justice and abundance of righteousness he will not belittle. (Job 37:23)
- Say to God; How fear-inspiring your works are! Because of the abundance of your strength your enemies will come cringing to you. (Psalms 66:3)
- The Israelites would experience many maledictions if they failed to rejoice and have joy of heart over the abundance of everything their God provided to them. Certainly the same holds true toward spiritual blessings.
- Due to the fact that you did not serve Yehowah your God with rejoicing and joy of heart for the abundance of everything. (Deuteronomy 28:47)
- Hannah's distraught demeanor was not from wine, but because of an abundance of deep concern.
- Do not make your slave girl like a good-for-nothing woman, for it

is out of the abundance of my concern and my vexation that I have spoken until now. (1 Samuel 1:16)

- Yehowah's people took from the abundance of his blessing to build his temple.
- O Yehowah our God, all this abundance that we have prepared to build for you a house for your holy name, from your hand it is, and to you it all belongs. (1 Chronicles 29:16)
- The queen of Sheba saw the abundance of Solomon's wisdom and riches.
- And I did not put faith in their words until I had come that my own eyes might see, and, look! There has not been told me the half of the abundance of your wisdom. You have surpassed the report that I have heard. (2 Chronicles 9:6)
- Furthermore, the king made the silver in Jerusalem like the stones, and cedarwood he made like the sycamore trees that are in the Shephelah for abundance. (2 Chronicles 9:27)
- Yehowah can bless one with an abundance of good things, if one is faithful.
- And Yehowah kept the kingdom firmly established in his hand, and all Judah continued to give presents to Jehoshaphat, and he came to have riches and glory in abundance. (2 Chronicles 17:5)
- But one's abundance can lead one to sin against Yehowah.
- And Jehoshaphat came to have riches and glory in abundance, but he formed a marriage alliance with Ahab. (2 Chronicles 18:1)
- So years later he went down to Ahab at Samaria, and Ahab proceeded to sacrifice sheep and cattle in abundance for him and for the people that were with him. And he began to allure him to go up against Ramoth-gilead. (2 Chronicles 18:2)
- And they went capturing fortified cities and a fat soil and taking in possession houses full of all good things, cisterns hewn out, vineyards and olive groves and trees for food in abundance, and they began to eat and to be satisfied and to grow fat and to luxuriate in your great goodness. (Nehemiah 9:25)

- Sometimes after a victory of war an abundance of spoil was taken.
- So Jehoshaphat and his people came to plunder the spoil on them, and they got to find among them in abundance both goods and clothing and desirable articles, and they went stripping them off for themselves until they could carry no more. And it came to be three days that they were plundering the spoil, for it was abundant. (2 Chronicles 20:25)
- When asked God's people willingly provided an abundance for the upkeep of Yehowah's place of worship.
- And it came about at the proper time he would bring the chest to the care of the king by the hand of the Levites, and, as soon as they saw that there was plenty of money, the secretary of the king and the commissioner of the chief priest came and then emptied the chest and lifted it up and returned it to its place. That was the way they did from day to day, so that they gathered money in abundance. (2 Chronicles 24:11)
- Then Azariah the chief priest of the house of Zadok said to him, yes, he said; From the time they started to bring the contribution into the house of Yehowah there has been an eating and getting satisfied and having a surplus in abundance, for Yehowah himself has blessed his people, and what has been left over is this great plenty. (2 Chronicles 31:10)
- Yehowah blessed his Kings with an abundance of good things who served him faithfully.
- And cities he acquired for himself, and also livestock of the flock and of the herd in abundance, for God gave him very many goods. (2 Chronicles 32:29)
- Yehowah abundant loving-kindness allows sinful men to freely approach his majesty.
- As for me, in the abundance of your loving-kindness I shall come into your house, I shall bow down toward your holy temple in fear of you. (Psalms 5:7)
- But as for me, my prayer was to you, O Yehowah, at an

acceptable time, O God. In the abundance of your loving-kindness answer me with the truth of salvation by you. (Psalms 69:13)

- As for our forefathers in Egypt, they did not show any insight into your wonderful works. They did not remember the abundance of your grand loving-kindness, but they behaved rebelliously at the sea, by the Red Sea. (Psalms 106:7)
- And he would remember concerning them his covenant, and he would feel regret according to the abundance of his grand lovingkindness. (Psalms 106:45)
- The loving-kindnesses of Yehowah I shall mention, the praises of Yehowah, according to all that Yehowah has rendered to us, even the abundant goodness to the house of Israel that he has rendered to them according to his mercies and according to the abundance of his loving-kindnesses. (Isaiah 63:7)
- While kings trust in their abundant military might is Yehowah who gives the victory.
- There is no king saved by the abundance of military forces, a mighty man himself is not delivered by the abundance of power. (Psalms 33:16)
- The horse is a deception for salvation, and by the abundance of its vital energy it does not afford escape. (Psalms 33:17)
- God promises abundant peace in the future.
- But the meek one's themselves will possess the earth, and they will indeed find their exquisite delight in the abundance of peace. (Psalms 37:11)
- In his days the righteous one will sprout, and the abundance of peace until the moon is no more. (Psalms 72:7)
- To the abundance of the princely rule and to peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David and upon his kingdom in order to establish it firmly and to sustain it by means of justice and by means of righteousness, from now on and to time indefinite. The very zeal of Yehowah of armies will do this. (Isaiah 9:7)

- Here I am bringing up for her a recuperation and health, and I will heal them and reveal to them an abundance of peace and truth. (Jeremiah 33:6)
- Though wicked one's prosper abundantly in their wicked system yet the righteous one is better off in the long run.
- Better is the little of the righteous one than the abundance of the many wicked ones. (Psalms 37:16)
- Those who are trusting in their means of maintenance, and who keep boasting about the abundance of their riches. (Psalms 49:6)
- Here is the able-bodied man that does not put God as his fortress, but that trusts in the abundance of his riches, that takes shelter in adversities by him. (Psalms 52:7)
- Yehowah's abundant mercy will do away with sin forever.
- Show me favor, O God, according to your loving-kindness. According to the abundance of your mercies wipe out my transgressions. (Psalms 51:1)
- Yehowah's abundant blessing is what enriches mankind.
- You have turned your attention to the earth, that you may give it abundance, you enrich it very much. The stream from God is full of water. You prepare their grain, for that is the way you prepare the earth. (Psalms 65:9)
- Just as God provided abundant water for his people in a wilderness so likewise he supplies water of spiritual truth.
- He proceeded to split rocks in the wilderness, that he might cause them to drink an abundance just like watery deeps. (Psalms 78:15)
- God's servants in this world experience an abundance of trouble and so look to God for comfort.
- Show us favor, O Yehowah, show us favor, for to an abundance we have been glutted with contempt. (Psalms 123:3)
- No one is good except God, and his goodness is abundant.

- With the mention of the abundance of your goodness they will bubble over, and because of your righteousness they will cry out joyfully. (Psalms 145:7)
- Yehowah's abundant greatness cannot be over-emphasized.
- Praise him for his works of mightiness. Praise him according to the abundance of his greatness. (Psalms 150:2)
- Where there is no discipline there is abundant foolishness.
- He will be the one to die because there is no discipline, and because in the abundance of his foolishness he goes astray. (Proverbs 5:23)
- A prostitute possesses abundant persuasiveness.
- She has misled him by the abundance of her persuasiveness. By the smoothness of her lips she seduces him. (Proverbs 7:21)
- An abundance of speech will cause transgression so wise one's act discreetly.
- In the abundance of words there does not fail to be transgression, but the one keeping his lips in check is acting discreetly. (Proverbs 10:19)
- Human needs are simple but a life of abundance without justice is hard to bear.
- Better is a little with righteousness than an abundance of products without justice. (Proverbs 16:8)
- Many precious things exist in abundance but knowledge is better than them all.
- There exists gold, also an abundance of corals, but the lips of knowledge are precious vessels. (Proverbs 20:15)
- The more we grow in wisdom, the more pain we experience because we see the need for change.
- For in the abundance of wisdom there is an abundance of

vexation, so that he that increases knowledge increases pain. (Ecclesiastes 1:18)

- After an abundance of days even Satan will be dealt with.
- And they will certainly be gathered with a gathering as of prisoners into the pit, and be shut up in the dungeon, and after an abundance of days they will be given attention. (Isaiah 24:22)
- Yehowah's anger is abundant against kings who have oppressed his people and taught false worship to them.
- For his Topheth is set in order from recent times, it is also prepared for the king himself. He has made its pile deep. Fire and wood are in abundance. The breath of Yehowah, like a torrent of sulphur, is burning against it. (Isaiah 30:33)
- Since matter is bundled energy, he who made the mighty stars has an abundance of energy.
- Raise your eyes high up and see. Who has created these things? It is the One who is bringing forth the army of them even by number, all of whom he calls even by name. Due to the abundance of dynamic energy, he also being vigorous in power, not one of them is missing. (Isaiah 40:26)
- Babylon will suffer Yehowah's wrath because of the abundance of her sorceries.
- But to you these two things will come suddenly, in one day: loss of children and widowhood. In their complete measure they must come upon you, for the abundance of your sorceries, for the full might of your spells, exceedingly. (Isaiah 47:9)
- Stand still, now, with your spells and with the abundance of your sorceries, in which you have toiled from your youth, that perhaps you might be able to benefit, that perhaps you might strike people with awe. (Isaiah 47:12)
- Yehowah will come against all of the non-spiritual one's of the earth with an abundance of power.
- Who is this one coming from Edom, the one with garments of glowing colors from Bozrah, this one who is honorable in his

clothing, marching in the abundance of his power? I, the One speaking in righteousness, the One abounding in power to save. (Isaiah 63:1)

- Israel was warned about the abundance of her error, which would cause her to be treated violently.
- And when you will say in your heart, Why is it that these things have befallen me? Because of the abundance of your error your skirts have been taken off as a cover, your heels have been treated violently. (Jeremiah 13:22)
- All those intensely loving you are the ones that have forgotten you. You are not the one for whom they keep searching. For with the stroke of an enemy I have struck you, with the chastisement of someone cruel, on account of the abundance of your error, your sins have become numerous. (Jeremiah 30:14)
- Why do you cry out on account of your breakdown? Your pain is incurable on account of the abundance of your error, your sins have become numerous. I have done these things to you. (Jeremiah 30:15)
- The days of being given attention must come, the days of the due payment must come. Those of Israel will know it. The prophet will be foolish, the man of inspired expression will be maddened on account of the abundance of your error, even animosity being abundant. (Hosea 9:7)
- Tarshish contained an abundance of material wealth for she traded with all the nations of the world and she eventually became haughty because of her abundance
- Tarshish was your merchant because of the abundance of all sorts of valuable things. For its silver, iron, tin and lead, your stores were given. (Ezekiel 27:12)
- Edom was your merchant because of the abundance of your works. For turquoise, wool dyed reddish purple and material of various colors and fine fabric and corals and rubies, your stores were given in exchange. (Ezekiel 27:16)
- Damascus was your merchant in the abundance of your works, because of the abundance of all your valuable things, with the

wine of Helbon and the wool of reddish gray. (Ezekiel 27:18)

- When your stores went forth from the open sea, you satisfied many peoples. With the abundance of your valuable things and your articles of exchange you made earth's kings rich. (Ezekiel 27:33)
- By the abundance of your wisdom, by your sales goods, you have made your wealth abound, and your heart began to be haughty because of your wealth. (Ezekiel 28:5)
- Because of the abundance of your sales goods they filled the midst of you with violence, and you began to sin. And I shall put you as profane out of the mountain of God, and I shall destroy you, O cherub that is covering, from the midst of the fiery stones. (Ezekiel 28:16)
- Owing to the abundance of your errors, because of the injustice of your sales goods, you have profaned your sanctuaries. And I shall bring forth a fire from the midst of you. It is what must devour you. And I shall make you ashes upon the earth before the eyes of all those seeing you. (Ezekiel 28:18)
- Satan is described as a beautiful tree of abundant foliage in the Garden of Eden.
- Pretty is the way that I made it in the abundance of its foliage, and all the other trees of Eden that were in the garden of the true God kept envying it. (Ezekiel 31:9)
- As Yehowah would bless his people they would turn to other gods and thank them for his abundant goodness.
- Israel is a degenerating vine. Fruit he keeps putting forth for himself. In proportion to the abundance of his fruit he has multiplied his altars. In proportion to the goodness of his land, they put up good pillars. (Hosea 10:1)
- False religion is like a harlot who has ensuared all the nations by her abundant acts of prostitution.
- Owing to the abundance of the acts of prostitution of the prostitute, attractive with charm, a mistress of sorceries, she who is ensnaring nations by her acts of prostitution and families

by her sorceries. (Nahum 3:4)

- Jerusalem would again become a place where old men could retain an abundance of respect in their old age,
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; There will yet sit old men and old women in the public squares of Jerusalem, each one also with his staff in his hand because of the abundance of his days. (Zechariah 8:4)
- Jesus called the religious leaders of his day wicked offer out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks.
- Offspring of vipers, how can you speak good things, when you are wicked? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. (Matthew 12:34)
- People who have spiritual appreciation will eventually have it in abundance,
- For to everyone that has, more will be given and he will have abundance, but as for him that does not have, even what he has will be taken away from him. (Matthew 25:29)
- A good man brings forth good out of the good treasure of his heart, but a wicked man brings forth what is wicked out of his wicked treasure, for out of the hearts abundance his mouth speaks. (Luke 6:45)
- Life does not result from the abundance of material wealth we may possess,
- Then he said to them; Keep your eyes open and guard against every sort of covetousness, because even when a person has an abundance his life does not result from the things he possesses. (Luke 12:15)
- The Christ's interest in the congregation is for what purpose.
- The thief does not come unless it is to steal and slay and destroy. I have come that they might have life and might have it in abundance. (John 10:10)

- Yehowah's forgiving of the human family shows an abundance of undeserved kindness.
- For if by the trespass of the one man death ruled as king through that one, much more will those who receive the abundance of the undeserved kindness and of the free gift of righteousness rule as kings in life through the one person, Jesus Christ. (Romans 5:17)
- Paul showed with what abundant joy the Macedonian brothers shared in the relief work.
- That during a great test under affliction their abundance of joy and their deep poverty made the riches of their generosity abound. (2 Corinthians 8:2)
- Paul never worried about his provisions but knew how to have an abundance or to be in want.
- I know indeed how to be low on provisions, I know indeed how to have an abundance. In everything and in all circumstances I have learned the secret of both how to be full and how to hunger, both how to have an abundance and how to suffer want. (Philippians 4:12)
- Fellow Christians appreciated Paul's work and saw to it, that he had an abundance so that he could continue in it.
- However, I have all things in full and have an abundance. I am filled, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the things from you, a sweet-smelling odor, an acceptable sacrifice, well-pleasing to God. (Philippians 4:18)
