

~ACCOMPLISH (71)

[English, achieve, complete, finish, get done, bring about, carry out, realize, opposite of, **do nothing**]

- Job felt that as a sinful man what could he **accomplish** against God and what could he possibly know that God does not know.
- If I have sinned, what can I **accomplish** against you, the Observer of mankind? Why is it that you have set me as your target, so that I should become a burden to you? (**Job 7:20**)
- It is higher than heaven. What can you **accomplish**? It is deeper than Sheol. What can you know? (**Job 11:8**)
- Wicked men think wrongly that God has no control over them.
- Who are saying to the true God; Turn away from us! And what can the Almighty **accomplish** against us? (**Job 22:17**)
- Job rightly recognized that we can **accomplish** nothing against God.
- If you actually sin, what do you **accomplish** against him? And if your revolts actually increase, what do you do to him? (**Job 35:6**)
- All of mankind's **accomplishments** are vanity and a striving after wind or judgment
- And I, even I, turned toward all the works of mine that my hands had done and toward the hard work that I had worked hard to **accomplish**, and, look! Everything was vanity and a striving after wind, and there was nothing of advantage under the sun. (**Ecclesiastes 2:11**)
- These false religious nations have become weary of keeping the obligation of the **high place**. Their service to God is habitual and perfunctory and their prayer **accomplishes** nothing.
- And it occurred that it was seen that Moab was made weary upon the high place, and he came to his sanctuary to pray, and he could not **accomplish** anything. (**Isaiah 16:12**)

- Though Israel experienced the labor pains of pregnancy, all that they could give birth to was **wind** or judgment, for they must stay as exiles in Babylon for the next seventy years. They brought children to birth there in exile but they **accomplished** nothing as regards their Promised Land.
- We have become pregnant, we have had labor pains, as it were, we have given birth to wind. No real salvation do we **accomplish** as regards the land, and no inhabitants for the productive land proceed to fall in birth. (**Isaiah 26:18**)
- The works the Christ **accomplished** bore witness about who he was.
- But I have the witness greater than that of John, for the very works that my Father assigned me to **accomplish**, the works themselves that I am doing, bear witness about me that the Father dispatched me. (**John 5:36**)
- Paul showed that it would take all of our abilities to **accomplish** fully our ministry for there were many opposers.
- You, though, keep your senses in all things, suffer evil, do the work of an evangelizer, fully **accomplish** your ministry. (**2 Timothy 4:5**)
