

~ACCOUNTING (139)

[English, Answering to authority, giving details, calling to responsibility]

- An **accounting** was not expected of the men doing the repair work for the temple for it was in faithfulness, that they came to do the work.
- And they would not call for an **accounting** with the men into whose hand they would give the money to give to the doers of the work, because it was with faithfulness that they were working. (2 Kings 12:15)
- Only no **accounting** should be taken of the money with them into whose hand it is being put, for it is in faithfulness that they are working. (2 Kings 22:7)
- God will call for an **accounting** from all men.
- Then what can I do when God rises up? And when he calls for an **accounting**, what can I answer him? (Job 31:14)
- And now because his anger has not called for an **accounting**, he has also not taken note of the extreme rashness. (Job 35:15)
- The wicked disrespect God thinking he will not call for an **accounting**.
- Why is it that the wicked one has disrespected God? He has said in his heart; You will not require an **accounting**. (Psalms 10:13)
- However Yehowah repeatedly promises to hold an **accounting** with all men.
- And it must occur that when Yehowah terminates all his work in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem, I shall make an **accounting** for the fruitage of the insolence of the heart of the king of Assyria and for the self-importance of his loftiness of eyes. (Isaiah 10:12)
- Should I not take an **accounting** because of these very things? Is the utterance of Yehowah. Or upon a nation that is like this should not my soul avenge itself? (Jeremiah 5:9)

- Should I not hold an **accounting** because of these very things, is the utterance of Yehowah, or on a nation that is like this should not my soul avenge itself? (**Jeremiah 5:29**)
- For this is what Yehowah of armies has said; Cut down wood and throw up against Jerusalem a siege rampart. She is the city with which an **accounting** must be held. She is nothing but oppression in the midst of her. (**Jeremiah 6:6**)
- Did they feel shame because it was something detestable that they had done? For one thing, they positively do not feel any shame, for another thing, they have not come to know even how to feel humiliated. Therefore they will fall among those who are falling, in the time that I must hold an **accounting** with them they will stumble, Yehowah has said. (**Jeremiah 6:15**)
- Because of these things should I not hold an **accounting** with them? Is the utterance of Yehowah. Or upon a nation that is like this should not my soul avenge itself? (**Jeremiah 9:9**)
- Look! Days are coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will hold an **accounting** with everyone circumcised but still in uncircumcision. (**Jeremiah 9:25**)
- I will also hold an **accounting** against you according to the fruitage of your dealings, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will set a fire ablaze in her forest, and it will certainly devour all the things round about her. (**Jeremiah 21:14**)
- And I will hold an **accounting** against those dwelling in the land of Egypt, just as I held an **accounting** against Jerusalem, with the sword, with the famine and with the pestilence. (**Jeremiah 44:13**)
- And Yehowah went on to say to him; Call his name Jezreel, for yet a little while and I must hold an **accounting** for the acts of bloodshed of Jezreel against the house of Jehu, and I must cause the royal rule of the house of Israel to cease. (**Hosea 1:4**)
- And I will hold an **accounting** against her for the days of the Baal images to which she kept making sacrificial smoke, when she kept decking herself with her ring and her ornament and kept going after her passionate lovers, and I was the one that she

forgot, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Hosea 2:13**)

- And it will have to become for the people the same as for the priest, and I shall certainly hold an **accounting** against them for their ways, and their dealings I shall bring back upon them. (**Hosea 4:9**)
- I shall not hold an **accounting** against your daughters because they commit fornication, and against your daughters-in-law because they commit adultery. For, as to the men, it is with the harlots that they get off to themselves, and with the female temple prostitutes that they sacrifice, and a people that does not understand will be trodden down. (**Hosea 4:14**)
- As my gift sacrifices they kept sacrificing flesh, and they kept eating what Yehowah himself took no pleasure in. Now he will remember their error and hold an **accounting** for their sins. To Egypt they themselves proceeded to return. (**Hosea 8:13**)
- And Yehowah has a legal case with Judah, even to hold an **accounting** against Jacob according to his ways, according to his dealings he will repay him. (**Hosea 12:2**)
- You people only have I known out of all the families of the ground. That is why I shall hold an **accounting** against you for all your errors. (**Amos 3:2**)
- For, in the day of my holding an **accounting** for the revolts of Israel against him, I will also hold an **accounting** against the altars of Bethel, and the horns of the altar will certainly be cut off and must fall to the earth. (**Amos 3:14**)
- Against the shepherds my anger has grown hot, and against the goatlike leaders I shall hold an **accounting**, for Yehowah of armies has turned his attention to his drove, the house of Judah, and has made them like his horse of dignity in the battle. (**Zechariah 10:3**)
- For Yehowah will make an **accounting** on the earth, concluding it and cutting it short. (**Romans 9:28**)
- And there is not a creation that is not manifest to his sight, but all things are naked and openly exposed to the eyes of him with whom we have an **accounting**. (**Hebrews 4:13**)
