

~ACCURATE (122)

[English precise, correct, exact, true, truthful, perfect, opposite of inaccurate]

- **Accurate** means in accord with a standard and men's scales and measuring devices should always be **accurate** measurements.
- You should prove to have **accurate** scales, **accurate** weights, an **accurate** ephah and an **accurate** hin. Yehowah your God I am, who have brought you out of the land of Egypt. (**Leviticus 19:36**)
- A weight **accurate** and just you should continue to have. An ephah **accurate** and just you should continue to have, in order, that your days may become long on the soil that Yehowah your God is giving you. (**Deuteronomy 25:15**)
- He will weigh me in **accurate** scales and God will get to know my integrity. (**Job 31:6**)
- **Accurate** scales and an accurate ephah and an accurate bath measure you men should come to have. (**Ezekiel 45:10**)
- Courts should find out the accurate facts of a matter.
- He said; The Jews have agreed to request you to bring Paul down to the Sanhedrin tomorrow as though intending to learn something more **accurate** about him. (**Acts of Apostles 23:20**)
- Men who think **inaccurately** of God he gives up to a disapproved mental state.
- And just as they did not approve of holding God in **accurate** knowledge, God gave them up to a disapproved mental state, to do the things not fitting. (**Romans 1:28**)
- The Law produced an **accurate** knowledge of sin.
- Therefore by works of Law no flesh will be declared righteous before him, for by Law is the **accurate** knowledge of sin. (**Romans 3:20**)

- Zeal alone without **accurate** knowledge will not gain God's favor. Paul and others repeatedly stress the importance of **accurate** knowledge in our sacred service.
- For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to **accurate** knowledge. (**Romans 10:2**)
- That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the **accurate** knowledge of him. (**Ephesians 1:17**)
- Until we all attain to the oneness in the faith and in the **accurate** knowledge of the Son of God, to a full-grown man, to the measure of stature that belongs to the fullness of the Christ. (**Ephesians 4:13**)
- And this is what I continue praying, that your love may abound yet more and more with **accurate** knowledge and full discernment. (**Philippians 1:9**)
- That is also why we, from the day we heard of it, have not ceased praying for you and asking that you may be filled with the **accurate** knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual comprehension. (**Colossians 1:9**)
- In order to walk worthily of Yehowah to the end of fully pleasing him as you go on bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the **accurate** knowledge of God. (**Colossians 1:10**)
- That their hearts may be comforted, that they may be harmoniously joined together in love and with a view to all the riches of the full assurance of their understanding, with a view to an **accurate** knowledge of the sacred secret of God, namely, Christ. (**Colossians 2:2**)
- And clothe yourselves with the new personality, which through **accurate** knowledge is being made new according to the image of the One who created it. (**Colossians 3:10**)
- Whose will is that all sorts of men should be saved and come to an **accurate** knowledge of truth. (**1 Timothy 2:4**)
- Instructing with mildness those not favorably disposed, as perhaps God may give them repentance leading to an **accurate**

knowledge of truth. (2 Timothy 2:25)

- Always learning and yet never able to come to an **accurate** knowledge of truth. (2 Timothy 3:7)
- Paul, a slave of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ according to the faith of God's chosen one's and the **accurate** knowledge of the truth which accords with godly devotion (Titus 1:1)
- For if we practice sin willfully after having received the **accurate** knowledge of the truth, there is no longer any sacrifice for sins left. (Hebrews 10:26)
- May undeserved kindness and peace be increased to you by an **accurate** knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord. (2 Peter 1:2)
- Forasmuch as his divine power has given us freely all the things that concern life and godly devotion, through the **accurate** knowledge of the one who called us through glory and virtue. (2 Peter 1:3)
- For if these things exist in you and overflow, they will prevent you from being either inactive or unfruitful regarding the **accurate** knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Peter 1:8)
- Certainly if, after having escaped from the defilements of the world by an **accurate** knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they get involved again with these very things and are overcome, the final conditions have become worse for them than the first. (2 Peter 2:20)
