## ~ACHAICUS (15) (A-cha'i-cus) [Of or Belonging to Achaia]

- One of the mature associates of the Corinthian congregation, who, together with Stephanas and Fortunatus, visited Paul while he was at Ephesus.
- But I rejoice over the presence of Stephanas and Fortunatus and Achaicus, because they have made up for your not being here. (1 Corinthians 16:17)
- For they have refreshed my spirit and yours. Therefore recognize men of that sort. (1 Corinthians 16:18)
