- A city in the southern part of the Promised Land, in the territory of Judah.
- And Keilah and Achzib and Mareshah, nine cities and their settlements. (Joshua 15:44)
- It is understood to be the same as Chezib the birthplace of Judah's son Shelah.
- In the Shephelah there were Eshtaol and Zorah and Ashnah. (Joshua 15:33)
- Shows it to be in the hilly country of the Shephelah, and it is tentatively identified with Tell el-Beida, Horvat Lavnin, 5 kilometers (3 miles) West-Southwest of Adullam. Lachish, Moresheth-gath, and Mareshah mentioned along with Achzib in;
- Attach the chariot to the team of horses, O inhabitress of Lachish. The beginning of sin was what she was to the daughter of Zion, for in you the revolts of Israel have been found. (Micah 1:13)
- Therefore you will give parting gifts to Moresheth-gath. The houses of Achzib were as something deceitful to the kings of Israel. (Micah 1:14)
- The dispossessor I shall yet bring to you, O inhabitress of Mareshah. As far as Adullam the glory of Israel will come. (Micah 1:15)
