~ADAMI-NEKEB (17) (Ad'a-mi-ne'keb) [Ground of Piercing or Boring]

- A place in the southern part of Naphtali.
- And their boundary came to be from Heleph, from the big tree in Zaanannim, and Adami-nekeb and Jabneel as far as Lakkum, and its terminations came to be at the Jordan. (Joshua 19:33)
- Its site is generally identified as Khirbet et-Tell, Tel Adami, above and West of Khirbet ed-Damiyeh, about 16 kilometers (10 miles) East-Northeast of Nazareth and approximately midway between Tiberias and Mount Tabor. Its position commanded a pass on an old caravan route between Gilead and the Plain of Acco.
