[English, sufficiently, passably, tolerably, effectively, satisfactorily, Opposite of, inadequately]

- Yehowah alone is the one who appoints men to his service and then he adequately qualifies them to do his bidding.
- To the latter one's an odor issuing from death to death, to the former one's an odor issuing from life to life. And who is adequately qualified for these things? (2 Corinthians 2:16)
- Not that we of ourselves are adequately qualified to reckon anything as issuing from ourselves, but our being adequately qualified issues from God. (2 Corinthians 3:5)
- Who has indeed adequately qualified us to be ministers of a New Covenant, not of a written code, but of spirit, for the written code condemns to death, but the spirit makes alive. (2 Corinthians 3:6)
- And the things you heard from me with the support of many witnesses, these things commit to faithful men, who, in turn, will be adequately qualified to teach others. (2 Timothy 2:2)
