**[English, sufficiently, passably, tolerably, effectively, satisfactorily,
Opposite of, inadequately]**

- Yehowah alone is the one who appoints men to his service and then he **adequately** qualifies them to do his bidding.
- To the latter one's an odor issuing from death to death, to the former one's an odor issuing from life to life. And who is **adequately** qualified for these things? (**2 Corinthians 2:16**)
- Not that we of ourselves are **adequately** qualified to reckon anything as issuing from ourselves, but our being adequately qualified issues from God. (**2 Corinthians 3:5**)
- Who has indeed **adequately** qualified us to be ministers of a New Covenant, not of a written code, but of spirit, for the written code condemns to death, but the spirit makes alive. (**2 Corinthians 3:6**)
- And the things you heard from me with the support of many witnesses, these things commit to faithful men, who, in turn, will be **adequately** qualified to teach others. (**2 Timothy 2:2**)
