~ADIN (30) (A'din) [Pleasure-Given]

- One of the paternal heads of Israel, several hundred of whose descendants returned from Babylonian exile with Zerubbabel.
- The sons of Adin, four hundred and fifty-four. (Ezra 2:15)
- The sons of Adin, six hundred and fifty-five. (Nehemiah 7:20)
- Later, 51 more of his lineage returned with Ezra in 468 B.C.E.
- And of the sons of Adin, Ebed the son of Jonathan, and with him fifty males. (Ezra 8:6)
- A princely representative of Adin's paternal house was among those who attested to the trustworthy arrangement drawn up in the days of Nehemiah.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
- Adonijah, Bigvai, Adin. (Nehemiah 10:16)
