[English, revproving, cautioning, warning, reprimanding, rebuking]

- Admonishing his Christian brothers was a work that Paul was actively engaged in so as to present the congregation to Christ unspotted and unblemished.
- Therefore keep awake, and bear in mind that for three years, night and day, I did not quit admonishing each one with tears. (Acts of Apostles 20:31)
- He is the one we are publicizing, admonishing every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man complete in union with Christ. (Colossians 1:28)
- This work of admonishing one another was one Paul encouraged all in the congregation to participate in.
- Let the word of the Christ reside in you richly in all wisdom.

 Keep on teaching and admonishing one another with psalms, praises to God, spiritual songs with graciousness, singing in your hearts to Yehowah. (Colossians 3:16)
- Paul encouraged his brothers to have regard for those working hard and admonishing them.
- Now we request you, brothers, to have regard for those who are working hard among you and presiding over you in the Lord and admonishing you. (1 Thessalonians 5:12)
- Admonishing is a warm hearted encouragement to good works.
- And yet do not be considering him as an enemy, but continue admonishing him as a brother. (2 Thessalonians 3:15)
