~ADONIKAM (32)

(Ad-o-ni'kam) [My Lord Has Raised Himself Up, that is, to help]

- A founder of one of the paternal houses of Israel. More than 600 members of this family returned to Jerusalem with Zerubbabel after the exile at Babylon.
- The sons of Adonikam, six hundred and sixty-six. (Ezra 2:13)
- The sons of Adonikam, six hundred and sixty-seven. (Nehemiah 7:18)
- An additional 63 members of this paternal house accompanied Ezra to Jerusalem in 468 B.C.E.
- And of the sons of Adonikam, those who were the last, and these were their names, Eliphelet, Jeiel and Shemaiah, and with them sixty males. (Ezra 8:13)
- When the representatives of the paternal houses attested to the trustworthy arrangement, or resolution drawn up in Nehemiah's day, this family was apparently listed by the name Adonijah.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)
