

~ADVISED (41)

[English, counseled, gave advice, directed, recommended, gave an opinion, warned, informed, told]

- Rehoboam was **advised** by the older men, but he left this counsel and did what his young men told him to do.

- Job showed that his companions had not done like him for he had **advised** those lacking in wisdom.

- Ahaz king of Judah was counseled not to worry about Remeliah who had **advised** what is bad against Judah.
- For the reason that Syria with Ephraim and the son of Remaliah has **advised** what is bad against you, saying; (**Isaiah 7:5**)
- On Paul's journey to Rome the majority **advised** leaving the harbor for another for it was not good for wintering
- Now as the harbor was inconvenient for wintering, the majority **advised** setting sail from there, to see if they could somehow make it to Phoenix to winter, a harbor of Crete that opens toward the northeast and toward the southeast. (**Acts of Apostles 27:12**)
