- Moses father-in-law Jethro advised Moses to split the responsibilities among many men so as not to wear himself out.
- Now listen to my voice. I shall advise you, and God will prove to be with you. You yourself serve as representative for the people before the true God, and you yourself must bring the cases to the true God. (Exodus 18:19)
- Balak gave his advice.
- And now here I am going away to my people. Do come, let me advise you what this people will do to your people afterward in the end of the days. (Numbers 24:14)
- Jeremiah told Zedekiah that even if he advised him he would not listen to his counsel.
- At this Jeremiah said to Zedekiah; In case I should tell you, will you not without fail put me to death? And in case I advise you, you will not listen to me. (Jeremiah 38:15)
- Christ advised the congregations to buy from him gold refined by fire so as to become rich.
