- **Now as Peter was going through all parts he came down also to the holy one's that dwelt in Lydda. (Acts of Apostles 9:32)**
- **There he found a certain man named **Aeneas**, who had been lying flat on his cot for eight years, as he was paralyzed. (Acts of Apostles 9:33)**
- **And Peter said to him, **Aeneas**, Jesus Christ heals you. Rise and make up your bed. And he rose immediately. (Acts of Apostles 9:34)**
