A man of Lydda, alongside the Plains of Sharon, healed by Peter after being paralyzed for eight years.

- Now as Peter was going through all parts he came down also to the holy one's that dwelt in Lydda. (Acts of Apostles 9:32)
- There he found a certain man named Aeneas, who had been lying flat on his cot for eight years, as he was paralyzed. (Acts of Apostles 9:33)
- And Peter said to him, Aeneas, Jesus Christ heals you. Rise and make up your bed. And he rose immediately. (Acts of Apostles 9:34)
- And all those who inhabited Lydda and the plain of Sharon saw him, and these turned to the Lord. (Acts of Apostles 9:35)
