

~AFFLICTING (52)

[English, troubling, bothering, making miserable, badly affecting, causing problems, worrying, upsetting, distressing]

- Laban warned Jacob not to **afflict** his daughters.
- If you go to **afflicting** my daughters and if you go to taking wives in addition to my daughters, there is no man with us. See! God is a witness between me and you. (**Genesis 31:50**)
- Israel was **afflicted** by the Egyptians in Egypt.
- And the Egyptians went treating us badly and **afflicting** us and putting hard slavery upon us. (**Deuteronomy 26:6**)
- Solomon prayed for Israel when they sinned and repented because Yehowah kept **afflicting** them.
- When heaven is shut up so that no rain occurs, because they kept sinning against you, and they actually pray toward this place and laud your name, and from their sin they turn back, because you kept **afflicting** them. (**1 Kings 8:35**)
- Consequently Yehowah rejected all the seed of Israel and kept **afflicting** them and giving them into the hand of pillagers, until he had cast them away from before him. (**2 Kings 17:20**)
- When the heavens are shut up so that no rain occurs because they kept sinning against you, and they actually pray toward this place and laud your name and from their sin they turn back because you kept **afflicting** them. (**2 Chronicles 6:26**)
- Your people, O Yehowah, they keep crushing, and your inheritance they keep **afflicting**. (**Psalms 94:5**)
- In Yehowah's New Order a reversal of conditions will occur and Israel will no longer be **afflicted**.
- And to you the sons of those **afflicting** you must go, bowing down, and all those treating you disrespectfully must bend down at the very soles of your feet, and they will have to call you the city of Yehowah, Zion of the Holy One of Israel. (**Isaiah 60:14**)

- Here I am acting against all those **afflicting** you, at that time, and I will save her that is limping, and her that is dispersed I shall collect together. And I will set them as a praise and as a name in all the land of their shame. (**Zephaniah 3:19**)
