~AFFLICT (94)

[English, trouble, bother, make miserable, badly affect, cause problems, worry, upset, distress]

- Abraham was told that his seed would be afflicted four hundred years.
- And he began to say to Abram; You may know for sure that your seed will become an alien resident in a land not theirs, and they will have to serve them, and these will certainly afflict them for four hundred years. (Genesis 15:13)
- Moreover, God spoke to this effect, that his seed would be alien residents in a foreign land and the people would enslave them and afflict them for four hundred years. (Acts of Apostles 7:6)
- Israel was counseled not to afflict a widow or fatherless boy for Yehowah would intercede for them.
- You people must not afflict any widow or fatherless boy. (Exodus 22:22)
- If you should afflict him at all, then if he cries out to me at all, I shall unfailingly hear his outcry. (Exodus 22:23)
- In the tenth day of the seventh month all Israel was to afflict their souls and not do any work.
- And it must serve as a statute to time indefinite for you people: In the seventh month on the tenth of the month you should afflict your souls, and you must not do any work, either the native or the alien resident who is residing as an alien in your midst. (Leviticus 16:29)
- It is a Sabbath of complete rest for you, and you must afflict your souls. It is a statute to time indefinite. (Leviticus 16:31)
- However, on the tenth of this seventh month is the day of atonement. A holy convention should take place for you, and you must afflict your souls and present an offering made by fire to Yehowah. (Leviticus 23:27)

- It is a Sabbath of complete rest for you, and you must afflict your souls on the ninth of the month in the evening. From evening to evening you should observe your Sabbath. (Leviticus 23:32)
- And on the tenth of this seventh month you should hold a holy convention, and you must afflict your souls. No sort of work must you do. (Numbers 29:7)
- The ships of Kittim would certainly afflict Assyria.
- And there will be ships from the coast of Kittim, and they will certainly afflict Assyria, and they will indeed afflict Eber. But he too will eventually perish. (Numbers 24:24)
- When a married woman took an oath of affliction her husband had the prior right to accept or to annul it.
- Any vow or any oath of an abstinence vow to afflict the soul, her husband should establish it or her husband should annul it. (Numbers 30:13)
- Yehowah promised a place where the sons of unrighteousness would not afflict Israel.
- And I shall certainly appoint a place for my people Israel and plant them, and they will indeed reside where they are, and no more will they be disturbed, and the sons of unrighteousness will not afflict them again as they did at the first. (2 Samuel 7:10)
- No enemy will make exactions upon him, neither will any son of unrighteousness afflict him. (Psalms 89:22)
- Yehowah refused to take note of his people afflicting themselves through fasting when they are still driving this slaves to work. This was not the kind of fasting he approved of.
- For what reason did we fast and you did not see, and did we afflict our soul and you would take no note? Indeed you people were finding delight in the very day of your fasting, when there were all your toilers that you kept driving to work. (Isaiah 58:3)
- Should the fast that I choose become like this, as a day for earthling man to afflict his soul? For bowing down his head just like a rush, and that he should spread out mere sackcloth and

ashes as his couch? Is it this that you call a fast and a day acceptable to Yehowah? (Isaiah 58:5)
