

~AGREEABLE (57)

[English, pleasant, pleasing, pleasurable, enjoyable, delightful, satisfying, to your liking, good]

- Saul was warned that his own disobedience would cost him the kingship and then that Yehowah would choose a man to replace him who was **agreeable** to his own heart.
- And now your kingdom will not last. Yehowah will certainly find for himself a man **agreeable** to his heart, and Yehowah will commission him as a leader over his people, because you did not keep what Yehowah commanded you. (1 Samuel 13:14)
- And after removing him, he raised up for them David as king, respecting whom he bore witness and said; I have found David the son of Jesse, a man **agreeable** to my heart, who will do all the things I desire. (Acts of Apostles 13:22)
- The Messiah though under stress felt that the measuring line for him had fallen in pleasant places, places that were **agreeable** to him.
- The measuring lines themselves have fallen for me in pleasant places. Really, my own possession has proved **agreeable** to me. (Psalms 16:6)
- The speaking of the girl companion was **agreeable**.
- Your lips are just like a scarlet thread, and your speaking is **agreeable**. Like a segment of pomegranate are your temples behind your veil. (Song of Solomon 4:3)
- Paul counseled that if an unbelieving mate was **agreeable** to dwelling with them, they should not split up.
- But to the others I say; yes, I, not the Lord; If any brother has an unbelieving wife, and yet she is **agreeable** to dwelling with him, let him not leave her. (1 Corinthians 7:12)
- And a woman who has an unbelieving husband, and yet he is **agreeable** to dwelling with her, let her not leave her husband. (1 Corinthians 7:13)

- For someone to bear up under stress because of conscience toward God, his suffering is something **agreeable** to God.
- For if someone, because of conscience toward God, bears up under grievous things and suffers unjustly, this is an **agreeable** thing. (**1 Peter 2:19**)
- For what merit is there in it if, when you are sinning and being slapped, you endure it? But if, when you are doing good and you suffer, you endure it, this is a thing **agreeable** with God. (**1 Peter 2:20**)
