- Nebuchadnezzar felt that his counselors had **agreed** to lie before him to save their own souls.
- For if you do not make known to me the very dream, this one and only sentence is upon you. But it is a lying and wrong word that you have **agreed** to say before me, until the time itself is changed. Therefore tell me the very dream, and I shall know that you can show the very interpretation of it. (**Daniel 2:9**)
- The vineyard owner **agreed** with his workers ahead of time as to their pay.
- When he had **agreed** with the workers for a denarius a day, he sent them forth into his vineyard. (**Matthew 20:2**)
- But in reply to one of them he said; Fellow, I do you no wrong. You **agreed** with me for a denarius, did you not? (**Matthew 20:13**)
- Judas had **agreed** to a sign by which to betray Christ.
- Now his betrayer had given them an **agreed** sign, saying, Whoever it is I kiss, this is he, take him into custody and lead him away safely. (**Mark 14:44**)
- Well, they rejoiced and **agreed** to give him silver money. (**Luke 22:5**)
- Annanias and his wife Sapphira **agreed** to deceive their brothers and God by lying about the price for which they sold a field.
- So Peter said to her; Why was it **agreed** upon between you two to make a test of the spirit of Yehowah? Look! The feet of those who buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out. (**Acts of Apostles 5:9**)
- The Jews **agreed** to request that Paul be brought down to the Sanhedrin Hall as part of a conspiracy to kill him.

- He said; The Jews have **agreed** to request you to bring Paul down to the Sanhedrin tomorrow as though intending to learn something more accurate about him. (**Acts of Apostles 23:20**)
