

## **~AGREEMENT (108)**

**[English, accord, concord, conformity, harmony, union, concurrence, contract, Opposite of - disagreement]**

- **Yehowah made an everlasting covenant with David for it was in **agreement** with his own heart to do so.**
- **For the sake of your word and in **agreement** with your own heart you have done all these great things to cause your servant to know them. (2 Samuel 7:21)**
- **O Yehowah, for the sake of your servant and in **agreement** with your own heart you have done all these great things by making all the great achievements known. (1 Chronicles 17:19)**
- **Yehowah's Messiah requests prophetically for Yehowah to hear his legal case in **agreement** with Yehowah's promise to support the lowly ones.**
- **O do conduct my legal case and recover me, preserve me alive in **agreement** with your saying; (Psalms 119:154)**
- **Among upright one's there is **agreement**.**
- **Foolish are those who make a derision of guilt, but among the upright one's there is **agreement**. (Proverbs 14:9)**
- **Yehowah promises to give Israel shepherds in **agreement** with his own soul who would spiritually feed his people.**
- **And I will give you shepherds in **agreement** with my heart, and they will certainly feed you with knowledge and insight. (Jeremiah 3:15)**
- **Israel tried to get away from God's justice but he would spread his net over them and discipline them in **agreement** with justice.**
- **Whichever way they go, I shall spread out over them my net. Like flying creatures of the heavens I shall bring them down. I shall discipline them in **agreement** with the report to their assembly. (Hosea 7:12)**

- False witnesses testified against Jesus, but their testimonies were not in **agreement**.
- Many, indeed, were giving false witness against him, but their testimonies were not in **agreement**. (**Mark 14:56**)
- But neither on these grounds was their testimony in **agreement**. (**Mark 14:59**)
- The unrighteous steward took back prior **agreements** and reduced them thus making friends by means of these unrighteous riches.
- He said; A hundred bath measures of olive oil. He said to him; Take your written **agreement** back and sit down and quickly write fifty. (**Luke 16:6**)
- Next, he said to another one, Now you, how much are you owing? He said; A hundred cor measures of wheat. He said to him, Take your written **agreement** back and write eighty. (**Luke 16:7**)
- The blind man's parents feared to tell the truth for the Jews had come to **agreement** that anyone confessing Jesus would be disfellowshipped.
- His parents said these things because they were in fear of the Jews, for the Jews had already come to an **agreement** that, if anyone confessed him as Christ, he should get expelled from the synagogue. (**John 9:22**)
- Christians should all speak in **agreement**, thus when new understanding comes forth it should be carefully examined by all and a consensus met.
- Now I exhort you, brothers, through the name of our Lord Jesus Christ that you should all speak in **agreement**, and that there should not be divisions among you, but that you may be fitly united in the same mind and in the same line of thought. (**1 Corinthians 1:10**)
- Finally, brothers, continue to rejoice, to be readjusted, to be comforted, to think in **agreement**, to live peaceably, and the God of love and of peace will be with you. (**2 Corinthians 13:11**)

- **There is no **agreement** between God's temple and idols.**
- **And what **agreement** does God's temple have with idols? For we are a temple of a living God, just as God said, I shall reside among them and walk among them, and I shall be their God, and they will be my people. (2 Corinthians 6:16)**
