~AHIEZER 1 (38) (A-hi-e'zer) [My Brother Is a Helper]

- Son of Ammishaddai and chieftain of the tribe of Dan, selected a year after the Exodus.
- And Yehowah proceeded to speak to Moses in the wilderness of Sinai, in the tent of meeting, on the first day of the second month in the second year of their coming out of the land of Egypt, and he said. (Numbers 1:1)
- And some men should be with you, one man to a tribe, each is a head to the house of his fathers. (Numbers 1:4)
- Of Dan, Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai. (Numbers 1:12)
- In this capacity he assisted Moses with the census, commanded the rearguard three-tribe division when on the march, and presented his offering on the tenth day of the inauguration of the altar at the tabernacle.
- The three-tribe division of the camp of Dan will be toward the north in their armies, and the chieftain for the sons of Dan is **Ahiezer** the son of Ammishaddai. (Numbers 2:25)
- On the tenth day there was the chieftain for the sons of Dan, Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai. (Numbers 7:66)
- And for a communion sacrifice two cattle, five rams, five hegoats, five male lambs each a year old. This was the offering of Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai. (Numbers 7:71)
- And the three-tribe division of the camp of the sons of Dan pulled away as forming the rear guard for all the camps in their armies, and Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai was over its army.
