- A descendant of Benjamin through Bela.
- As for Benjamin, he became father to Bela his firstborn, Ashbel the second and Aharah the third. (1 Chronicles 8:1)
- Nohah the fourth and Rapha the fifth. (1 Chronicles 8:2)
- And Bela came to have sons, Addar and Gera and Abihud. (1 Chronicles 8:3)
- And Abishua and Naaman and Ahoah. (1 Chronicles 8:4)
- Perhaps the same as Ahijah in,
- And Naaman and Ahijah, and Gera, he was the one that took them into exile, and he became father to Uzza and Ahihud. (1 Chronicles 8:7)
- Some of his descendants, Ahohites, were prominent fighters in David's army.
- Ext to him Eleazar the son of Dodo the son of Ahohi was among the three mighty men with David when they taunted the Philistines. They had gathered themselves there for the battle, and so the men of Israel retreated. (2 Samuel 23:9)
- Zalmon the Ahohite, Maharai the Netophathite. (2 Samuel 23:28)
- And after him there was Eleazar the son of Dodo the Ahohite. He was among the three mighty men. (1 Chronicles 11:12)
- Sibbecai the Hushathite, Ilai the Ahohite. (1 Chronicles 11:29)
- And over the division of the second month there was Dodai the Ahohite with his division, and Mikloth was the leader, and in his division there were twenty-four thousand. (1 Chronicles 27:4)
