~AHUZZATH (20) (A-huz'zath) [Possession]

- The confidential friend who accompanied Abimelech, Philistine king of Gerar, on a visit to Isaac at Beer-sheba.
- Then he went up from there to Beersheba. (Genesis 26:23)
- Later on Abimelech came to him from Gerar with Ahuzzath his confidential friend and Phicol the chief of his army. (Genesis 26:26)
- This is the first reference in the Bible to a confidential friend, the trusted inner-circle position of one consulted for advice or authorized as spokesman.
