## ~AIN (24) (A'in) [Fountain, Spring]

- The word literally means eye, but by analogy is used to mean a natural spring or fountain as distinguished from a man-made well or tank, which latter water source is expressed by the Hebrew terms be 'er' and bohr.
- Offshoot of a fruit bearing tree, Joseph is the offshoot of a fruit bearing tree by the fountain, that propels its branches up over a wall. (Genesis 49:22)
- For Yehowah your God is bringing you into a good land, a land of torrent valleys of water, springs and watery deeps issuing forth in the valley plain and in the mountainous region. (Deuteronomy 8:7)
- It is often written En- when used in compounds, as En-rimmon, En-gedi, En-gannim.
