## ~ALMON-DIBLATHAIM (26) (Al'mon-dib-la-tha'im)

- A place between Dibon-gad and the mountains of Abarim where the Israelites encamped in the 40th year after their going out from Egypt 1473 B.C.E. It was one of the last encampments during their wanderings.
- After that they pulled away from Dibon-gad and went camping in Almon-diblathaim. (Numbers 33:46)
- Then they pulled away from Almon-diblathaim and went camping in the mountains of Abarim before Nebo. (Numbers 33:47)
- The site is not certain, but some scholars identify it with Khirbet Deleilat-esh-Sherqiyeh, about 16 kilometers (10 miles) North-Northeast of Dibon, or Dhiban. Possibly identical with Beth-diblathaim.
- And against Dibon and against Nebo and against Bethdiblathaim. (Jeremiah 48:22)
