~AMMIEL 4 (30) (Am'mi-el) [People of God]

- A Levite, the sixth son of Obed-edom. He was a gatekeeper who shared responsibility for the storehouses of the house of Yehowah during David's time.
- And Obed-edom had sons. Shemaiah the firstborn, Jehozabad the second, Joah the third and Sacar the fourth and Nethanel the fifth. (1 Chronicles 26:4)
- Ammiel the sixth, Issachar the seventh, Peullethai the eighth, for God had blessed him. (1 Chronicles 26:5)
- Of these divisions of the gatekeepers, the headmen had duties exactly as their brothers did, to minister at the house of Yehowah. (1 Chronicles 26:12)
- So they cast lots for the small the same as for the great by their paternal houses, for the different gates. (1 Chronicles 26:13)
- Then the lot to the east fell to Shelemiah. For Zechariah his son, a counselor with discretion, they cast the lots, and his lot got to come out to the north. (1 Chronicles 26:14)
- Obed-edom had his to the south, and his sons had the storehouses. (1 Chronicles 26:15)
