## ~AMOK (24) (A'mok) [Deep, Unintelligible]

- A principal priest who returned with Zerubbabel from exile in Babylon.
- And these were the priests and the Levites that went up with Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel and Jeshua, Seraiah, Jeremiah, Ezra. (Nehemiah 12:1)
- Sallu, Amok, Hilkiah, Jedaiah. These were the heads of the priests and their brothers in the days of Jeshua. (Nehemiah 12:7)
- His family was represented by his son Eber in the time of Joiakim.
- And in the days of Joiakim there happened to be priests, the heads of the paternal houses, for Seraiah, Meraiah, for Jeremiah, Hananiah. (Nehemiah 12:12)
- For Sallai, Kallai, for Amok, Eber. (Nehemiah 12:20)
