~AMRAM 1 (69) (Am'ram) [People High or Exalted]

- A grandson of Levi through Kohath.
- And these are the names of the sons of Levi, according to their family descents. Gershon and Kohath and Merari. And the years of Levis life were a hundred and thirty-seven years. (Exodus 6:16)
- And the sons of Kohath were Amram and Izhar and Hebron and Uzziel. And the years of Kohath's life were a hundred and thirty-three years. (Exodus 6:18)
- Now Amram took Jochebed his father's sister as his wife. Later she bore him Aaron and Moses. And the years of Amram's life were a hundred and thirty-seven years. (Exodus 6:20)
- And the sons of Kohath by their families were Amram and Izhar, Hebron and Uzziel. (Numbers 3:19)
- These were the families of the Levites. The family of the Libnites, the family of the Hebronites, the family of the Mahlites, the family of the Mushites, the family of the Korahites. And Kohath became father to Amram. (Numbers 26:58)
- And the sons of Kohath were Amram and Izhar and Hebron and Uzziel. (1 Chronicles 6:18)
- It is stated that he married his father's sister Jochebed, an act then allowable but later prohibited in the Mosaic Law.
- The nakedness of your father's sister you must not lay bare. She is the blood relation of your father. (Leviticus 18:12)
- Some translations, however, endeavor to show her to be his cousin. His children were Aaron, Miriam, and Moses.
- Now Amram took Jochebed his father's sister as his wife. Later she bore him Aaron and Moses. And the years of Amram's life were a hundred and thirty-seven years. (Exodus 6:20)

- And the name of Amram's wife was Jochebed, Levis daughter, whom his wife bore to Levi in Egypt. In time she bore to Amram, Aaron and Moses and Miriam their sister. (Numbers 26:59)
- And the sons of Kohath were Amram, Izhar and Hebron and Uzziel. (1 Chronicles 6:2)
- And the sons of Amram were Aaron and Moses, and there was Miriam. And the sons of Aaron were Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar. (1 Chronicles 6:3)
- The sons of Kohath were Amram, Izhar, Hebron and Uzziel, four. (1 Chronicles 23:12)
- The sons of Amram were Aaron and Moses. But Aaron was separated that he might sanctify the Most Holy, he and his sons to time indefinite, to make sacrificial smoke before Yehowah, to minister to him and to pronounce blessing in his name to time indefinite. (1 Chronicles 23:13)
