~ANAB (24) (A'nab) [Grape]

- A town in the South part of the hill country of Judah from which the giant Anakim were expelled by Joshua.
- Furthermore, at that particular time Joshua went and cut off the Anakim from the mountainous region, from Hebron, from Debir, from Anab and from all the mountainous region of Judah and from all the mountainous region of Israel. Along with their cities Joshua devoted them to destruction. (Joshua 11:21)
- And in the mountainous region Shamir and Jattir and Socoh. (Joshua 15:48)
- And Anab and Eshtemoh and Anim. (Joshua 15:50)
- The site is identified with Khirbet `Anab es-Saghireh, 1.5 kilometers (1 miles) West of Edh Dhahiriya, about halfway between Hebron and Beer-sheba. The original name of the city may have been Kiriath-anab, since Egyptian texts apparently mention it as *Qrt `nb*.
