[English, wiped out, destroyed, obliterated, extinguished, eradicated, exterminated, defeated, Opposite of, protected]

- Because of the wicked action of vengeance by Simeon and Levi Jacob feared that he would be annihilated by the people of the land.
- At this Jacob said to Simeon and to Levi; You have brought ostracism upon me in making me a stench to the inhabitants of the land, with the Canaanites and the Perizzites, whereas I am few in number, and they will certainly gather together against me and assault me and I must be annihilated, I and my house. (Genesis 34:30)
- The sons of Esau annihilated the Horites when they took Seir.
- Just the same as he did for the sons of Esau, who are dwelling in Seir, when he annihilated the Horites from before them, that they might dispossess them and dwell in their place until this day. (Deuteronomy 2:22)
- As for the Avvim, who were dwelling in settlements as far as Gaza, the Caphtorim, who came out from Caphtor, annihilated them, that they might dwell in their place. (Deuteronomy 2:23)
- Yehowah annihilated every man who willingly walked after the Baal of Peor.
- Your own eyes are the ones that saw what Yehowah did in the case of the Baal of Peor, that every man who walked after the Baal of Peor was the one whom Yehowah your God annihilated from your midst. (Deuteronomy 4:3)
- Moses warned Israel that worship of idols would cause Yehowah to annihilate them from off the good land.
- I do take as witnesses against you today the heavens and the earth, that you will positively perish in a hurry from off the land to which you are crossing the Jordan to take possession of it. You will not lengthen your days on it, because you will positively be annihilated. (Deuteronomy 4:26)

- Moses told Israel not to fear because Yehowah would rout their enemies until they were annihilated.
- And Yehowah your God will indeed abandon them to you and rout them with a great rout, until they are annihilated.

 (Deuteronomy 7:23)
- Yehowah warned Israel that even after they had annihilated their enemies that their gods might prove to be a snare for them.
- Watch out for yourself for fear you may be entrapped after them, after they have been annihilated from before you, and for fear you may inquire respecting their gods, saying; How was it these nations used to serve their gods? And I, yes, I, will do the same way. (Deuteronomy 12:30)
- Yehowah promised Israel that among many other maledictions for not listening to him and for serving other gods Israel would be annihilated from before him.
- Yehowah will send upon you the curse, confusion and rebuke in every undertaking of yours that you try to carry out, until you have been annihilated and have perished in a hurry, because of the badness of your practices in that you have forsaken me. (Deuteronomy 28:20)
- Yehowah will give powder and dust as the rain of your land. From the heavens it will come down upon you until you have been annihilated. (Deuteronomy 28:24)
- And all these maledictions will certainly come upon you and pursue you and overtake you until you have been annihilated, because you did not listen to the voice of Yehowah your God by keeping his commandments and his statutes that he commanded you. (Deuteronomy 28:45)
- And you will have to serve your enemies whom Yehowah will send against you with hunger and thirst and nakedness and the want of everything, and he will certainly put an iron yoke upon your neck until he has annihilated you. (Deuteronomy 28:48)
- And they will certainly eat the fruit of your domestic animals and the fruitage of your ground until you have been annihilated, and they will let no grain, new wine or oil, no young of your cattle or

- progeny of your flock, remain for you until they have destroyed you. (Deuteronomy 28:51)
- Also, any sickness and any plague that is not written in the book of this law, Yehowah will bring them upon you until you have been annihilated. (Deuteronomy 28:61)
- And Yehowah will certainly do to them just as he has done to Sihon and to Og, the kings of the Amorites, and to their land, when he annihilated them. (Deuteronomy 31:4)
- It was only humankind that they annihilated at Hazor.
- And all the spoil of these cities and the domestic animals the sons of Israel plundered for themselves. It was only all humankind that they struck with the edge of the sword until they had annihilated them. They did not let anyone that breathed remain. (Joshua 11:14)
- Joshua reiterated Moses maledictions against Israel for their failure to comply with Yehowah's commandments leading to their annihilation.
- And it must occur that, just as all the good word that Yehowah your God has spoken to you has come upon you, so Yehowah will bring upon you all the evil word until he has annihilated you from off this good ground that Yehowah your God has given you.

 (Joshua 23:15)
- Yehowah fought for his people and he annihilated them before his nation.
- Eventually I brought you to the land of the Amorites who were dwelling on the other side of the Jordan, and they went fighting against you. At that I gave them into your hand that you might take possession of their land, and I annihilated them from before you. (Joshua 24:8)
- After the sin of Benjamin womankind was nearly annihilated from Benjamin.
- Consequently the older men of the assembly said, What shall we do to the men that are left over as to wives, for womankind has been annihilated out of Benjamin? (Judges 21:16)

- Jeroboam's offspring were annihilated for their exceeding idolatry and wickedness.
- And it came about that as soon as he became king, he struck down all the house of Jeroboam. He did not let anyone breathing remain of Jeroboam's until he had annihilated them, according to Yehowah's word that he had spoken by means of his servant Ahijah the Shilonite. (1 Kings 15:29)
- Zimri annihilated the whole house of Baasha at Yehowah's command.
- Thus Zimri annihilated the whole house of Baasha, according to the word of Yehowah that he had spoken against Baasha by means of Jehu the prophet. (1 Kings 16:12)
- Ahab's seed were likewise annihilated due to Yehowah's word spoken by Elijah.
- Finally he came to Samaria. Now he went striking down all who were left over of Ahab's in Samaria, until he had annihilated them, according to Yehowah's word that he had spoken to Elijah. (2 Kings 10:17)
- Jehu annihilated Baal worship out of Israel.
- Thus Jehu annihilated Baal out of Israel. (2 Kings 10:28)
- Manasseh seduced Judah to do worse than the nations that Yehowah had driven out of the Promised Land to give to Israel, which nations he annihilated.
- And Manasseh kept seducing Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to do worse than the nations that Yehowah had annihilated from before the sons of Israel. (2 Chronicles 33:9)
- And they did not listen, but Manasseh kept seducing them to do what was bad more than the nations whom Yehowah had annihilated from before the sons of Israel. (2 Kings 21:9)
- Israel eventually went practicing worship in the way of the nations that Yehowah had previously annihilated.

- And they began to act unfaithfully toward the God of their forefathers and went having immoral intercourse with the gods of the peoples of the land, whom God had annihilated from before them. (1 Chronicles 5:25)
- Haman tried to pass a decree to have all of the Jew annihilated.
- And a copy of the writing of the Law that had been given in Shushan to have them annihilated he gave him to show Esther and to tell her and to lay the command upon her to come in to the king and implore favor of him and make request directly before him for her own people. (Esther 4:8)
- For we have been sold, I and my people, to be annihilated, killed and destroyed. Now if we had been sold for mere men slaves and for mere maidservants, I should have kept silent. But the distress is not appropriate when with damage to the king. (Esther 7:4)
- Transgressor against Yehowah will all be annihilated together
- But the transgressors themselves will certainly be annihilated together, the future of wicked people will indeed be cut off. (Psalms 37:38)
- When the wicked one's sprout as the vegetation and all the practicers of what is hurtful blossom forth, it is that they may be annihilated forever. (Psalms 92:7)
- The house of wicked people will be annihilated, but the tent of the upright one's will flourish. (Proverbs 14:11)
- Ones who are annihilated are left on the ground as manure or fertilizer.
- They were annihilated at En-dor, they became manure for the ground. (Psalms 83:10)
- If Yehowah's people would pay attention to his commands then they would never be annihilated from before him.
- And your offspring would become just like the sand, and the descendants from your inward parts like the grains of it. one's name would not be cut off or be annihilated from before me. (Isaiah 48:19)

- Yehowah promised to annihilate the land of Moab.
- And the despoiler will come in on every city, and there will be no city that can make its escape. And the low plain will certainly perish and the level land be annihilated, a thing that Yehowah has said. (Jeremiah 48:8)
- And Moab will certainly be annihilated from being a people, for it is against Yehowah that he has put on great airs. (Jeremiah 48:42)
- Yehowah promised to bring against Pharaoh the tyrants of the nations to bring Egypt to ruin and all her crowd will be annihilated.
- I shall cause your crowd to fall by the very swords of mighty ones, the tyrants of the nations, all of them, and they will actually despoil the pride of Egypt, and all her crowd must be annihilated. (Ezekiel 32:12)
- Yehowah promised to annihilate the high places of Beth-aven for their idolatrous worship.
- And the high places of Beth-aven, the sin of Israel, will actually be annihilated. Thorns and thistles themselves will come up upon their altars. And people will in fact say to the mountains; Cover us! And to the hills; Fall over us! (Hosea 10:8)
- Yehowah annihilated the Amorites for the same practices his people Israel were practicing.
- But as for me, I had annihilated the Amorite on account of them, whose height was like the height of cedars, and who was vigorous like the massive trees, and I went annihilating his fruitage above and his roots below. (Amos 2:9)
- Christians are encouraged to be peaceable with one another so as not to get annihilated by one another.
- If, though, you keep on biting and devouring one another, look out that you do not get annihilated by one another. (Galatians 5:15)
