~ANNIHILATE (303)

[English, wipe out, destroy, obliterate, extinguish, eradicate, exterminate, defeat, Opposite of, protect]

- Yehowah would wipe out completely and destroy all mention of false worship through idols.
- And I shall certainly annihilate your sacred high places and cut off your incense stands and lay your own carcasses upon the carcasses of your dungy idols, and my soul will simply abhor you. (Leviticus 26:30)
- And you must drive away all the inhabitants of the land from before you and destroy all their stone figures, and all their images of molten metal you should destroy, and all their sacred high places you should annihilate. (Numbers 33:52)
- The Israelite complained that Yehowah had brought them out of Egypt only to annihilate them through the Amorites.
- And you kept grumbling in your tents and saying; It was because Yehowah hated us that he brought us out of the land of Egypt to give us into the hand of the Amorites, to annihilate us. (Deuteronomy 1:27)
- The sons of Esau annihilated the Horites and dispossessed them.
- And the Horites dwelt in Seir in former times, and the sons of Esau proceeded to dispossess them and to annihilate them from before them and to dwell in their place, just the same as Israel must do to the land that is his holding, which Yehowah will certainly give to them. (Deuteronomy 2:12)
- The Israelites were warned that Yehowah was a God exacting exclusive devotion who would annihilate them, if they turned to other gods.
- For Yehowah your God in your midst is a God exacting exclusive devotion, for fear the anger of Yehowah your God may blaze against you and he must annihilate you from off the surface of the ground. (Deuteronomy 6:15)

- And it must occur that just as Yehowah exulted over you to do you good and to multiply you, so Yehowah will exult over you to destroy you and to annihilate you, and you will simply be torn away from off the soil to which you are going to take possession of it. (Deuteronomy 28:63)
- For he will turn your son from following me, and they will certainly serve other gods, and Yehowah's anger will indeed blaze against you, and he will certainly annihilate you in a hurry. (Deuteronomy 7:4)
- This served also as a protection to Israel who were being given the Promised Land, because of the nations whom Yehowah was annihilating, because of their false religious practice.
- A hiding place is the God of ancient time, and underneath are the indefinitely lasting arms. And he will drive away from before you the enemy, and he will say; Annihilate them! (Deuteronomy 33:27)
- And you well know today that Yehowah your God is crossing before you. A consuming fire he is. He will annihilate them, and he himself will subdue them before you, and you must dispossess them and destroy them speedily, just as Yehowah has spoken to you. (Deuteronomy 9:3)
- Yehowah spoke to Moses and wanted to annihilate his rebellious people and then make a more powerful nation out of Moses seed.
- And he was about to say to annihilate them, if it had not been for Moses his chosen one, who stood in the gap before him, to turn back his rage from bringing them to ruin. (Psalms 106:23)
- Let me alone that I may annihilate them and wipe out their name from under the heavens, and let me make you a nation mightier and more populous than they are. (Deuteronomy 9:14)
- Israel fell in defeat at Ai because they failed to annihilate the thing devoted to destruction from their victory over Jericho.
- And the sons of Israel will not be able to rise up against their enemies. The back is what they will turn before their enemies, because they have become a thing devoted to destruction. I shall not prove to be with you again unless you annihilate the

thing devoted to destruction out of your midst. (Joshua 7:12)

- The men of Gibeon feared Yehowah's order to annihilate all the inhabitants of Canaan.
- Then they answered Joshua and said; It was because your servants were plainly told that Yehowah your God had commanded Moses his servant to give you all the land and to annihilate all the inhabitants of the land from before you, and we became very much afraid for our souls because of you. So we did this thing. (Joshua 9:24)
- Yehowah let the hearts of the people of Canaan become hard toward Israel for the purpose of annihilating them.
- For it proved to be Yehowah's course to let their hearts become stubborn so as to declare war against Israel, in order, that he might devote them to destruction, that they might come to have no favorable consideration, but in order, that he might annihilate them, just as Yehowah had commanded Moses. (Joshua 11:20)
- Saul made David swear that he would not annihilate his seed after his death.
- So now do swear to me by Yehowah that you will not cut off my seed after me and that you will not annihilate my name out of the house of my father. (1 Samuel 24:21)
- The Tekoite woman pleaded with the king for the life of her son not to annihilate her seed.
- And here all the family have risen up against your maidservant and keep saying; Give over the striker of his brother, that we may put him to death for the soul of his brother whom he killed, and let us even annihilate the heir! And they will certainly extinguish the glow of my charcoals that has remained, so as to assign to my husband neither a name nor a remnant on the surface of the ground. (2 Samuel 14:7)
- But she said; Let the king, please, remember Yehowah your God, that the avenger of blood may not be continually causing ruin and that they may not annihilate my son. To this he said; As Yehowah is living, not a single hair of your son will fall to the earth. (2 Samuel 14:11)

- Because the king proceeded to listen so as to deliver his slave girl out of the palm of the man seeking to annihilate me and my lone son from the inheritance given by God. (2 Samuel 14:16)
- The Israelites were instructed not to annihilate the sons of Moab, Ammon and Seir.
- And now here the sons of Ammon, and Moab and the mountainous region of Seir, whom you did not allow Israel to invade when they were coming out of the land of Egypt, but they turned away from them and did not annihilate them. (2 Chronicles 20:10)
- And the sons of Ammon and Moab proceeded to stand up against the inhabitants of the mountainous region of Seir to devote them to destruction and annihilate them, and as soon as they finished with the inhabitants of Seir, they helped each one to bring his own fellow to ruin. (2 Chronicles 20:23)
- Haman sought to annihilate all of the Jews.
- But it was despicable in his eyes to lay hand upon Mordecai alone, for they had told him about Mordecai's people, and Haman began seeking to annihilate all the Jews who were in all the realm of Ahasuerus, Mordecai's people. (Esther 3:6)
- And there was a sending of the letters by means of couriers to all the kings jurisdictional districts, to annihilate, to kill and to destroy all the Jews, young man as well as old man, little ones and women, on one day, on the thirteenth day of the twelfth month, that is, the month Adar, and to plunder the spoil of them. (Esther 3:13)
- That the king granted to the Jews that were in all the different cities to congregate themselves and stand for their souls, to annihilate and kill and destroy all the force of the people and jurisdictional district that were showing hostility to them, little ones and women, and to plunder their spoil. (Esther 8:11)
- Israel was chastised for not annihilating the peoples devoted to destruction by Yehowah.
- They did not annihilate the peoples, as Yehowah had said to

them. (Psalms 106:34)

- Yehowah guards his people but the wicked one's he will annihilate.
- Yehowah is guarding all those loving him, but all the wicked one's he will annihilate. (Psalms 145:20)
- Yehowah brought up against Israel the Assyrians because annihilate was in their hearts.
- Though he may not be that way, he will feel inclined, though his heart may not be that way, he will scheme, because to annihilate is in his heart, and to cut off nations not a few. (Isaiah 10:7)
- The purpose of the Day of Yehowah is to annihilate the land's sinner out of it.
- Look! The day of Yehowah itself is coming, cruel both with fury and with burning anger, in order to make the land an object of astonishment, and that it may annihilate the land's sinners out of it. (Isaiah 13:9)
- Yehowah gave a command against Phonecia to annihilate her strongholds.
- His hand he has stretched out over the sea, he has caused kingdoms to be agitated. Yehowah himself has given a command against Phoenicia, to annihilate her strongholds. (Isaiah 23:11)
- Yehowah will turn against those acting as masters over Israel and annihilate them.
- They are dead. They will not live. Impotent in death, they will not rise up. Therefore you have turned your attention that you might annihilate them and destroy all mention of them. (Isaiah 26:14)
- Yehowah would annihilate his prophets who spoke forth his word to worshipers of mere dungy idols.
- And as for the prophet, in case he gets fooled and actually speaks a word, I myself, Yehowah, have fooled that prophet, and I will stretch out my hand against him and annihilate him from the

midst of my people Israel. (Ezekiel 14:9)

- Yehowah promised to annihilate Ammon and through this they would know Yehowah.
- Therefore here I anymore. I have stretched out my hand against you, and I will give you as something to plunder to the nations, and I will cut you off from the peoples and destroy you from the lands. I shall annihilate you, and you will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 25:7)
- Yehowah promised to annihilate fat one's among his flock who feed off of the flock and push others around.
- The lost one I shall search for, and the dispersed one I shall bring back, and the broken one I shall bandage and the ailing one I shall strengthen, but the fat one and the strong one I shall annihilate. I shall feed that one with judgment. (Ezekiel 34:16)
- The one horn that rose up against three would in turn be annihilated.
- And the Court itself proceeded to sit, and his own rulership they finally took away, in order to annihilate him and to destroy him totally. (Daniel 7:26)
- In the time of the end the king of the North would go forth with great rage and annihilate many.
- But there will be reports that will disturb him, out of the sunrising and out of the north, and he will certainly go forth in a great rage in order to annihilate and to devote many to destruction. (Daniel 11:44)
- Israel, the sinful Kingdom, Yehowah would annihilate, but he would preserve Judah.
- Look! The eyes of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah are upon the sinful kingdom, and he will certainly annihilate it from upon the surface of the ground. Nevertheless, I shall not completely annihilate the house of Jacob, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Amos 9:8)

- As he had done with the Canaanite cities before Israel Yehowah would annihilate Israel and her cities for their false worship.
- And I will uproot your sacred poles from the midst of you and annihilate your cities. (Micah 5:14)
- Yehowah's prophetic promise to Zerubbabel was to annihilate the strength of kingdoms and nations and to overthrow their military forces. He would annihilate all nations coming against Jerusalem.
- And I shall certainly overthrow the throne of kingdoms and annihilate the strength of the kingdoms of the nations, and I will overthrow the chariot and its riders, and the horses and their riders will certainly come down, each one by the sword of his brother. (Haggai 2:22)
- And it must occur in that day that I shall seek to annihilate all the nations that are coming against Jerusalem. (Zechariah 12:9)
- James and John asked Jesus if he wanted them to annihilate the Samaritans because they did not receive him well.
- When the disciples James and John saw this they said; Lord, do you want us to tell fire to come down from heaven and annihilate them? (Luke 9:54)
