

## ~ANNOUNCE (40)

[English, proclaim, make known, publicize, broadcast, declare, say, pronounce, state]

- Joseph was modest and told Pharaoh that God would **announce** welfare to Pharaoh.
- At this Joseph answered Pharaoh, saying; I need not be considered! God will **announce** welfare to Pharaoh. (**Genesis 41:16**)
- Israel was told to **announce** terms of peace before going in to destroy a city.
- In case you draw near to a city to fight against it, you must also **announce** to it terms of peace. (**Deuteronomy 20:10**)
- David chanted a dirge in which he said that the death of Saul should not be **announced** in Askelon, the territory of his enemies.
- Do not, you people, tell it in Gath, Do not **announce** it in the streets of Ashkelon, for fear that the daughters of the Philistines may rejoice, for fear that the daughters of the uncircumcised men may exult. (**2 Samuel 1:20**)
- All men are encouraged to announce the **salvation** that Yehowah gives.
- Sing to Yehowah, all you of the earth! **Announce** from day to day the salvation he gives! (**1 Chronicles 16:23**)
- In Yehowah's New Order the riches of the nations will come to Yehowah's house and they will **announce** the praises of Yehowah.
- The heaving mass of camels itself will cover you, the young male camels of Midian and of Ephah. All those from Sheba, they will come. Gold and frankincense they will carry. And the praises of Yehowah they will **announce**. (**Isaiah 60:6**)
