

~APPEAL (32)

[English, plea, petition, application, demand, request, call, ask]

- Jesus showed on the night of his arrest that he could **appeal** to his father for angelic help.
- Or do you think that I cannot **appeal** to my Father to supply me at this moment more than twelve legions of angels? (**Matthew 26:53**)
- As Stephen was stoned to death he made **appeal** to Yehowah to accept his sacrifice.
- And they went on casting stones at Stephen as he made **appeal** and said; Lord Jesus, receive my spirit. (**Acts of Apostles 7:59**)
- Paul, wrongly accused of sedition **appealed** to Caesar for justice
- If, on the one hand, I am really a wrongdoer and have committed anything deserving of death, I do not beg off from dying, if, on the other hand, none of those things exists of which these men accuse me, no man can hand me over to them as a favor. I **appeal** to Caesar! (**Acts of Apostles 25:11**)
- But when the Jews kept speaking against it, I was compelled to **appeal** to Caesar, but not as though I had anything of which to accuse my nation. (**Acts of Apostles 28:19**)
